ACTIVITIES AND GAMES

Activity 1: Who is it? (5-10 mins)

Aim

To revise lessons 78 - 84, providing opportunity for you to assess how much the children have understood and to identify any gaps in their knowledge.

Equipment needed

Either 1 copy of the Who is it? sheet for the class or a copy for each child. The pictures should be cut out in advance.

Instructions

- Ensure that the children know who each person is.
- Tell them that you will say something that one of these people might say and that they must point to or hold up the correct picture.
- Tell them that they may use each picture more than once.
- Read the statements below, rephrasing and repeating as necessary.

I am Jonathan's son.

I danced when the Ark came to Jerusalem.

I am David's son.

I couldn't walk.

I built the Temple in Jerusalem.

I asked God for wisdom.

God sent ravens to feed me when there was a drought.

I was willing to share my last meal.

I wouldn't sell my vineyard.

I worshipped Baal.

I wanted to kill Elijah.

I sulked when I couldn't have Naboth's vineyard.

I made a plan to have Naboth killed.

Activity 2: Dice Game (20 minutes)

Aim

To allow the children the opportunity to demonstrate their recall and understanding of lessons 82-84 and to allow you to identify any areas of confusion.

Equipment needed

You will need a set of Dice Game cards for each child. The pictures will need to be cut out in advance. You will also need 1 or 2 dice (see instructions).

Instructions

Place the sets of pictures in the middle.

The children take turns to roll the dice and collect the corresponding picture.

The first person to collect all 6 is the winner.

To speed up the game use 2 dice; don't add the scores but allow the player to choose which number to use. This increases the chances of getting the required picture.

The pictures do not have to be collected in sequence but each player can only collect one of each picture. If you are short of time, set a time limit e.g. 10 minutes, and see who has collected the most pictures.

However you choose to organise the activity, make sure each player can tell you a fact about each picture they collect. How does each picture link to Elijah?

Pictures:

1. Altar with fire
2. Prophets of Baal
3. Flour and oil
4. Poor widow gathering sticks
5. Raven
6. Ahab
