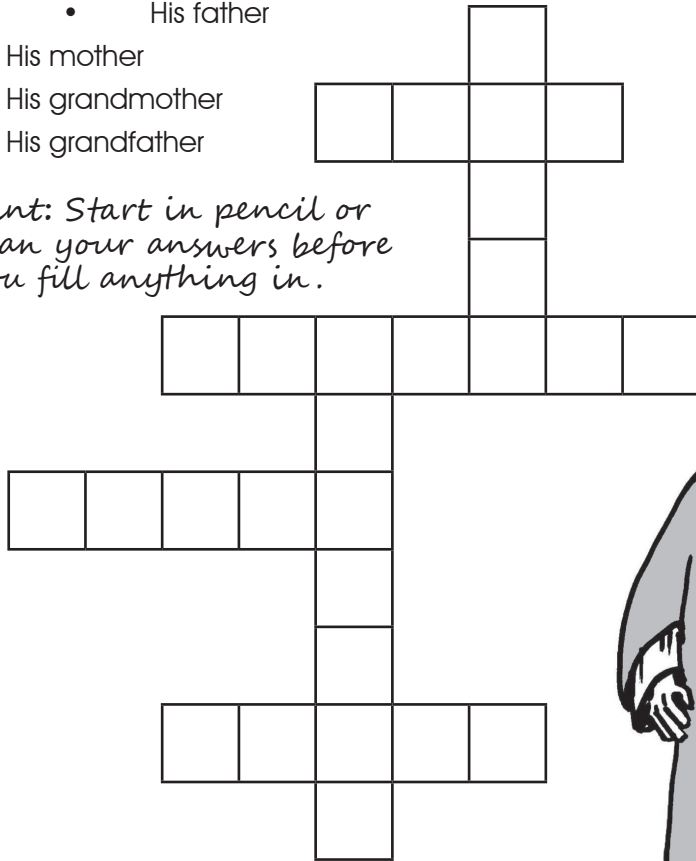


# Crossword

# Whopper Word Search

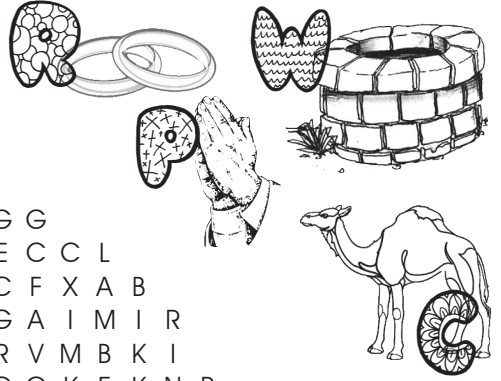
Use the clues to work out which words are hidden in the wordsearch about Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

When a wife was chosen:

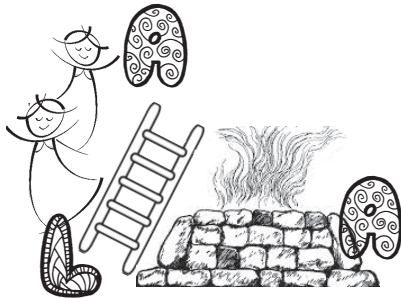


Which 2 **B**s did Jacob want but Esau had?
