Activities and Games

Activity 1: Make a Phrase

Aim

To answer questions and collect words to revise lessons 1- 6 and to make a phrase from each story using the words collected.

Equipment needed

- The Make a Phrase question sheets
- One copy of each of the Make a Phrase word sheets, maybe printed onto card, with the words cut up (the words or letters for each section are printed in a different fonts)

Instructions

1. Ask the children questions from the 'Make a Phrase' lists, giving them references if required. You may like to rephrase the questions or add ones of your own if you think it is better for the children. If they use the references, try to get them to pick out the answer and say it in their own words rather than read the verse to you.
2. For each correct answer the children are given a 'reward' word or letter. Once enough of the questions on each section are answered correctly, the children must then work together to rearrange the words (or letters) to form a relevant quotation (or word).
3. If there is enough room for the children to run around you can print each set of words onto different coloured paper and hide them around the room for the children to find. For example, section 1 'The Creation' reward words could be printed on blue paper, cut up and hidden around the room. The first child answers a question correctly and is then sent off to find a piece of blue paper. Likewise with more questions until they have all the words to enable them to make up the sentence.
