Activity 1: Words and Pictures

Aims

The aim of the game is to describe, using mime, pictures or verbal descriptions, the story on each card; and then to identify the principle being taught in each story.

Equipment Needed

- Words and Pictures sheet, stuck onto card and cut out into individual pictures
- Words and Pictures worksheet, either one for each child or one for a group of children
- Paper and pencils

Instructions

1. Place all the cards in a bag or face down on the table.
2. Taking it in turns each pupil takes a card and tells the rest of the class which number is on the card. Then, depending on the code, the pupil mimes, draws or tells the story omitting the stated words. The others have to guess which lesson or story it is.

m	Mime
d	Draw (like Pictionary)
s	Tell the story without using the words on the card

As each story is guessed the answers are written on the worksheets against the correct numbers.

3. Once all the stories have been written down the children are then to match up the Bible principles on their sheet to the stories they have written down, as shown in the completed table below.




