Activity 1: Paul's Picture Lotto

Aim

To use the game to review the events which happened to Paul.

Equipment needed

- One Paul's Picture Lotto game board
- One sheet of Picture Lotto pictures per player cut up the sheets to separate the pictures.
- Picture Lotto questions

Instructions

- Stack the pictures on top of their corresponding story title on the game board.
- Take it in turns to ask each student one question from each lesson set.
- A correct answer means they can take the card which corresponds to that lesson.
- The children should be able to talk about what is happening in each picture.
- Encourage them to put their pictures in chronological order as they collect them.

Activity 2: Paul's Journeys

Aim

To answer questions about places in which Paul preached.

Equipment needed

- Board game, photocopied and enlarged if needed
- Counters
- Dice

Instructions

This is a game for individual players or teams. The object of the game is to complete a journey from Damascus to Rome, visiting nine other places on the way. Players answer questions correctly in order to move on.

Each player starts at Damascus, and throws a dice to choose a question to answer. If the question is answered correctly, the player move on to Lystra, if not, he stays at Damascus and waits for his next turn. The process is repeated at each city.

At Crete there are only 3 questions to choose from, so the player has to throw 1-3. Similarly at Rome the player has to throw 1 or 2.

The winner is the first to reach Rome and answers a question correctly.



Questions for both "Picture Lotto" and "Paul's Journeys" games

(numbers by the questions are for the "Paul's Journeys" game and can be ignored for the Lotto game.)

Saul's journey to Damascus (Lesson 123)

- 1 What was Saul's goal in life before he went to Damascus? *To persecute Christians.*
- 2 What altered Saul's whole life and convinced him he had been working against God's wishes? *He saw a vision of the Lord Jesus.*
- How was Saul physically affected by his vision? He was blinded.
- Saul was not the only one to experience a vision: who else had a vision in Damascus? Ananias.
- 3 Why did Ananias have a vision? To convince him of Saul's change of heart.
- 4 What affect did Saul's vision have on his life? His life turned around. *He was baptised and became a follower of Jesus.*
- After Saul's conversion how did he spend his time? *Preaching wherever he went*.
- 5 How did the Pharisees and High Priest feel about Saul's conversion? They wanted to kill him.
- 6 Saul responded wholeheartedly to God's will. How can we show we wish to follow God in our lives? *Baptism etc many ideas..*
- Following Saul's conversion what did he change his name to? Paul.

Lystra (Lesson 127)

- Who did Jesus ask Paul to preach to? Gentiles.
- 1 Who accompanied Paul in Lystra? *Barnabus*.
- 2 Who did Paul heal in Lystra? A lame man.
- Why did Paul and Barnabas want to teach other people? (Many answers).
- 3 Who did the people from Lystra think Paul and Barnabus were? Gods in human form.
- 4 How did the crowd react when they saw Paul's miracle? *They wanted to offer sacrifices to Paul and Barnabas.*
- 5 Jews from Antioch came and persuaded the crowd. What did the crowd want to do having spoken to the Jews? *Kill Paul and Barnabas.*
- How did the crowd try and kill Paul? *By stoning.*
- 6 The crowd left Paul outside the city thinking he was dead. Did they succeed in killing Paul? *No, he got up with help from the disciples and went back into the city.*
- Where did Paul and Barnabas go the following Day? Derbe.

Paul and Silas at Philippi (Lesson 128)

- Whom did Paul take with him on his second journey? *Silas.*
- Who joined Paul and Silas whilst on their journey? *Timothy and Luke*.
- 1 Who was first converted at Philippi? Lydia.
- What did Lydia do for a living? Work with purple cloth.
- 2 Whom did Paul heal at Philippi? A slave girl who was a fortune teller.
- 3 The owners of the slave girl had Paul and Silas flogged and put in prison. Why? *They were angry they could no longer make money from the slave girl.*
- 4 What did Paul and Silas do in prison? *Pray and sing hymns*.
- Paul did not have an easy time when preaching God's word. It is easy to thank God when everything is going right. How can we do this when everything is going wrong? (Many answers).
- 5 What happened to the prison during the earthquake? *The doors opened and everybody's chains came loose.*
- 6 What affect did the earthquake have on the jailor? *Great fear and then conversion.*



Paul at Athens (Lesson 129)

- 1 Why did people go to Athens? To seek wisdom.
- 2 Where did the people of Athens invite Paul to speak to them? *Mars Hill, Areopagus.*
- 3 Which god did Paul say he had come to proclaim to the people of Athens? *The unknown god.*
- 4 Whom did Paul say the unknown god was? The God who made the world and everything in it is Lord of heaven and earth.
- Who was converted at Athens? *Dionysius and Damaris*.
- 5 What did Paul say about idols? Silver and gold images made by man should not be used to worship the living God.
- What idols in this life can stop us from following the living God? (Many answers).
- 6 What did Paul say God wanted the people of Athens to do? *Repent and believe in the resurrection of the dead.*
- How did the people of Athens answer Paul? We will hear you again on this subject.

Paul at Corinth (Lesson 130)

- 1 Why was Corinth a good place to preach the gospel? As a sea port people travelled from all over the world to Corinth and would take home with them the message of God's purpose.
- What did Paul do for a living? *Tent-maker.*
- 2 Whom did Paul meet and work with in Corinth? Aquila and Priscilla.
- What did Aquila, Priscilla and Paul have in common? They were Jews and tent-makers.
- 3 Who was the synagogue ruler at Corinth? *Crispus.*
- 4 What did God say to Paul in a vision at Corinth? Do not be afraid no harm will come to you because of the followers in the city.
- 5 We are not often locked away in prison but what should we do when we face difficult times in our lives? *Pray and trust God will look after us.*
- Who was the proconsul when the Jews took Paul to court? Gallio.
- 6 What did Gallio say to the Jews in court? *Settle the matter yourselves*.
- Paul was always having his beliefs questioned. What should we do when people doubt our beliefs? (Many answers).

Paul at Ephesus (Lesson 131)

- Which missionary journey was Paul on when he visited Ephesus? Third.
- How long did Paul stay in Ephesus? Two Years.
- 1 Which god did many of the people of Ephesus worship? Artemis/Diana.
- 2 Which silversmith made souvenirs of Artemis? *Demetrius*.
- 3 What did Paul tell the Ephesians about god's made by man? *Idols had no power and there is only one true God.*
- 4 Why was Demetrius angry with Paul? *His livelihood was threatened.*
- 5 What unusual miracle did God give Paul the power to do in Ephesus? *Materials like handkerchiefs that touched Paul healed people.*
- 6 Demetrius made a speech, which stirred up the people, and they became angry with all Christians. What did the crowd shout and for how long? *Great is Artemis (Diana) of the Ephesians, for 2 hours.*
- In our lives is demonstrating and following the crowd a good thing? (Many answers).
- What idols are there in our lives? (Many answers).

Paul at Troas (Lesson 132)

- 1 Which countries did Paul travel through on his third missionary journey? *Asia, Macedonia and Greece.*
- Name three people who travelled with Paul through Macedonia? *Sopater, Aristarchus, Secundus, Gaius, Trophimus, Tychicus and Timothy.*



- How long did Paul stay in Troas? 1 week.
- 2 Who was Eutychus? A young man who sat in a window listening to Paul speaking.
- Why did Eutychus fall asleep? He was tired because Paul had talked passed midnight.
- 3 What happened to Eutychus? *He fell to his death from a third storey window.*
- 4 Paul raised Eutychus from the dead. Did he then go and rest before his long journey to Jerusalem? No he went back up stairs broke bread, drank wine and talked for the rest of the night.
- 5 Why were the elders of Ephesus so upset to see Paul leave them? *They knew they would never see Paul again.*
- 6 Why did Paul revisit so many of the people who had responded to his preaching? (Many answers).
- How has Paul's work affected our lives today? (Many answers).

Paul on trial (Lesson 134)

- 1 The Jews were determined to kill Paul. Who did the Romans send Paul to see to keep him safe? *Felix, the Roman Governor of Judea.*
- The Jews travelled to Caesarea to Paul's trial. Of what did they accuse him? *Being a troublemaker and a heretic.*
- 2 Paul denied starting a riot but admitted being a follower of Jesus. What was Felix' judgement of the case? *He did not make one he adjourned the case.*
- Who was Felix' wife? Drusilla.
- 3 How long did Paul stay under house arrest? 2 years.
- Why so long? Felix was hoping for a bribe from the Jews.
- 4 Festus took over the providence from Felix what did Paul ask him to do? Send him to Caesar.
- Which royals came to visit Festus? King Agrippa and Bernice.
- 5 How did Paul defend himself in front of King Agrippa? *He described his life, conversion and his determination to carry out God's will.*
- 6 What was King Agrippa's verdict of the case? *If Paul had not appealed to Caesar he could have been set free.*
- At every opportunity Paul preached to people about Jesus and told them what he believed. How can we show others we believe in Jesus? *Our actions and by talking to our friends about Sunday school and the Bible.*

Paul's Shipwreck (Lesson 135)

Crete

- 1 Which Centurion was put in charge of Paul and the prisoners on the journey to Rome? *Julius*.
- 2 When they sailed to Crete, what request did Paul make to Julius? *That they winter in Crete because to sail would be too dangerous.*
- 3 Julius believed the owner of the ship over Paul and they sailed on. What happened? A great storm hit them and they did not see sun or stars.

Malta

- 1 How long was the ship in the storm? *14 days*.
- 2 How were the people on board saved? By putting their trust in Paul and believing he had received a message from an angel.
- 3 How many people were saved from the shipwreck? 276 every person on board.
- 4 By which island did the ship run aground? *Malta*.
- 5 What happened to Paul whilst on the island of Malta? *Paul was bitten by a viper and was unharmed. He healed Publius' father and anyone else with a disease and preached Gods word.*
- 6 Paul must have been very afraid when aboard the ship. When we are afraid what should we do? *(Many answers).*

Rome

- 1 When they arrived in Rome Paul was chained up and kept under house arrest. How did he spend his time? *Preaching to anyone visited him and writing letters to those he had converted.*
- 2 Paul wrote many of the letters we have in the Bible today whilst in Rome. Can you name any of them? *Ephesians, Colossians, Philippians and Philemon.*
