Activity 1: Who or what am I?

Aims

To remind the children of the people and events about which they have learned in recent lessons.

Equipment needed

- Sticky labels or Post-It notes
- Pens
- Bibles

Instructions

Write one of the names from the list below onto each of the labels or Post-It notes. Put one onto each child's back or forehead. The children should then sit in a circle and take turns to ask the other children questions, to find out who their character is. The questions should only have "yes" or "no" answers. If the answer to the question is "yes" they may ask another question. If it is "no" the next child can ask questions.

For example: a child has a label reading 'Jesus'. He asks, "Am I male?" As the answer is "yes" he can ask another question: "Did I kill people?" The answer to this is "no" so the next child becomes the questioner, who asks about his own character.

This list of names may help - obviously you will need to match the numbers in your class, although you can always play the game more than once.

Extension activity

Activity 2: Jesus our Saviour

Aim

To complete the game by answering the questions and moving forward and back as indicated.

Equipment

- Board, photocopied and preferably enlarged
- 1 set of the 'Place' questions mounted on card and cut out. Write 'P' on the back of each and put them in position on the board, and treat the 'Name', 'Event' and 'Teaching' questions similarly.
- Dice
- Counters

Instructions

Move round the board, picking up a P, N, T or E card as indicated. If a 'right' answer is given the counter is moved on one space, otherwise it is moved back one space. The winner is the first player to complete the game.

When a player lands in one of the corner squares, and moves forward or back seven spaces, you may like to take the opportunity to talk about the importance of praying, getting to know Jesus as a friend, and the futility of worry.
