Activities and Games

Activity 1: Beetle

Aim

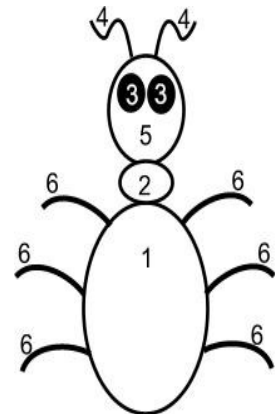
To complete a beetle drawing, having answered questions correctly.

Equipment needed.

- Paper and pencils
- dice,
- questions

Instructions

- The players take it in turns to roll the dice until a 1 is thrown.
- The player with the 1 is then asked a question which, if answered correctly allows them to draw a body. The question sheet has questions listed under numbers - these should correspond to the number shown on the dice i.e. if a player throws a 6, ask a question from the 6 section.
- Once each player has drawn a body, then they are able to add the beetle's legs and head.
- The antennae and the eyes may only be added once a head has been drawn.
- The person with a completed beetle is the winner.



Beetle Questions to answer if you throw a 1

Pentecost - The Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1 - 42)

What was the sign given to the apostles at Pentecost?

Name one of the gifts given to the apostles by the Holy Spirit.

What is talking in tongues?

What were the apostles accused of when the people saw their gifts and why was this unlikely?

What were the crowd urged to do by Peter during his speech at Pentecost?

How many people were baptised at Pentecost?

Questions to answer if you throw a 2

The Lame Man Healed (Acts 3:1 - 11)

What was the lame man doing at the gate of the temple called Beautiful?

What did Peter say he had 'none' of to the lame man?

In whose name did Peter heal the lame man?

Where did the lame man go after he was healed?

How did the healed man show that he was healed?

What did the healed man's friends say about it?

Questions to answer if you throw a 6

Stephen (Acts 6 & 7)

What was the job of the seven Deacons chosen by the twelve disciples for the early church?

What was Stephen accused of?

How did Stephen defend himself?

Of what did Stephen accuse the Elders?

Who did Stephen see when he looked up into heaven?

What did the Elders do to Stephen after his speech?

Who looked after the clothes of those stoning Stephen?

What did Stephen ask God and Jesus to do as he was dying?

Questions to answer if you throw a 4

Philip and the Ethiopian (Acts 8:26 - 40)

Who told Saul to go to the south between Jerusalem and Gaza?

What was the Ethiopian eunuch reading in his chariot?

What did Philip offer to do for the Ethiopian?

What did the Ethiopian ask Philip to do when they came across water?

What happened to Philip after he had baptised the Ethiopian Eunuch?

Questions to answer if you throw a 5

Dorcas (Acts 9:36 - 43)

- What was the disciple Dorcas (Tabitha) known for?
- What did the other disciples at Joppa do when Dorcas died?
- What did the widows show Peter that Dorcas had made for them?
- What did Peter do when he entered the room where Dorcas was?
- What happened after Peter had prayed to God?

Questions to answer if you throw a 3

Peter and Cornelius (Acts 10)

- Why was it unusual that Cornelius should believe in God?
- What did the angel tell Cornelius to do in his vision?
- What was the vision that Peter saw 3 times while he was hungry and praying on the roof?
- What did the voice urge Peter to do to the unclean animals he saw in his vision?
- What was Peter taught by his visit to Cornelius?
- What was the final outcome of Peter's visit to Cornelius?

Spare questions

Peter in Prison (Acts 12:1 - 19)

- Why did King Herod take Peter prisoner?
- What was the Church doing while Peter was in prison over the Passover period?
- How was Peter held in prison?
- Who visited Peter in jail?
- What did the Angel tell Peter to do and what happened?
- What did Rhoda do when Peter knocked at the door?
- What did Herod do to those supposed to be keeping guard on Peter?

You could also use the noughts and crosses questions if you run out and are not using the noughts and crosses game.



Activity 2: Noughts and Crosses

Aim

To assess the children's knowledge of the stories in this unit.

Equipment

- For each game, a copy of the Noughts and Crosses grid for each pair or team. (overleaf)
- Two different coloured counters to represent noughts and crosses, or pens to write in the squares or 'O's and 'X's written on paper to place on the grid when a question is answered correctly.
- Questions (below)

Instructions

- Either divide the class into teams or have pairs of players for this game.
- A question must be correctly answered before a cross or nought can be put down.
- The quiz questions as well as the following questions can be used.

Noughts and Crosses Questions

What was the visual sign that the apostles had received the Holy Spirit?

What did the people do who accepted Peter's message at Pentecost?

What was the name of the temple gate the lame man was sitting at?

What did the man do when he was healed?

What was Stephen's job in the church?

What was Stephen falsely accused of?

What was the Sanhedrin?

Why were the Jewish leaders so against Christianity?

Who else did the Sanhedrin falsely accuse?

Who baptised the Ethiopian man?

On which road did Philip meet the Ethiopian man?

Where was Peter when he was called to heal Dorcas?

What is the Aramaic version of Dorcas' name?

What happened when the rest of Joppa heard about the raising of Dorcas?

How was Peter feeling just before he had a vision?

What was Peter's vision about?

How was the vision connected to Cornelius?

Who ordered James' execution?

Who was Rhoda?

Why did she forget to open the door?
