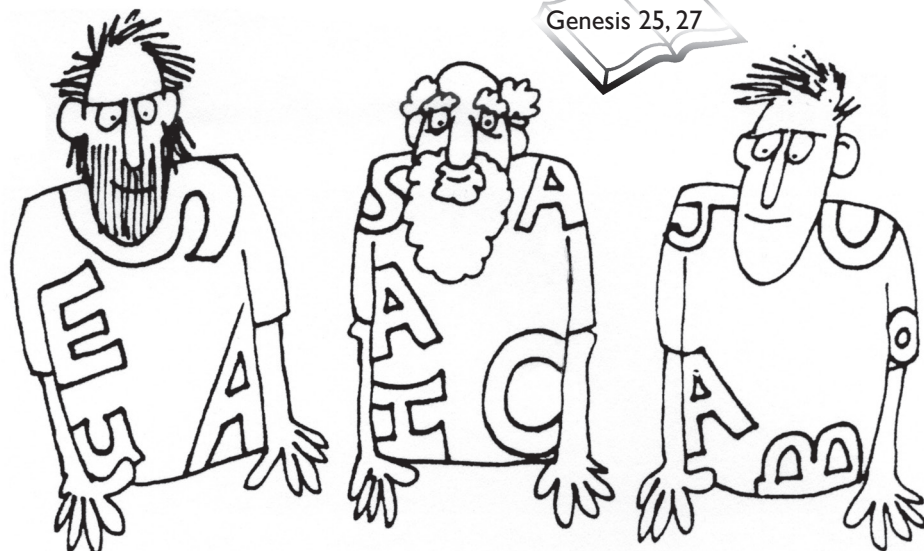


Jacob and Esau
