



Joseph in Egypt

Pyramids

The pyramids were built over 2000 years BC. Joseph would have seen them when he travelled through Egypt. Draw some to the left of the River Nile.



The River Nile

Go over the river Nile with a blue pen (you can do the Jordan as well if you know where it is). A small strip on either side of the Nile was good for growing corn. Colour this land green (don't make the width of the green more than 1 cm except at the top of the river).

Desert

The rest of Egypt is desert. Write DESERT to the left of the Red Sea and colour it yellow if you want.

The Land of Goshen

Where the River Nile enters the sea it splits up into lots of smaller rivers. This is called a delta because it is shaped like the Greek letter delta.



The land of Goshen was here. Write it in. You will hear about this in a few weeks.

The Red Sea

No one really knows why it is called the Red Sea. It may have appeared red or it may mean Sea of Reeds. Colour it blue. You may also like to colour the other seas.
