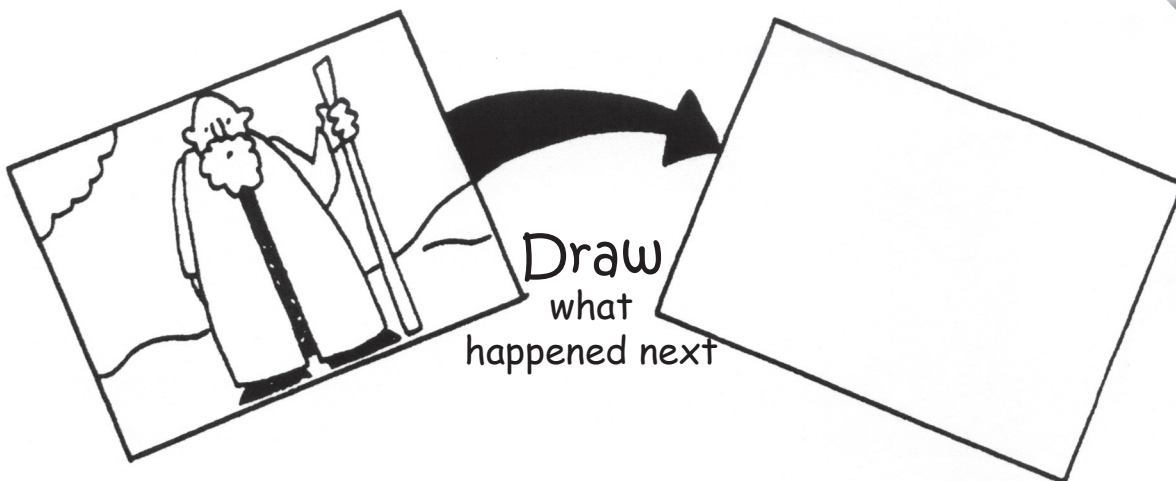
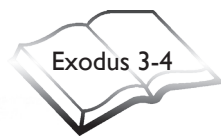


Moses - The burning bush

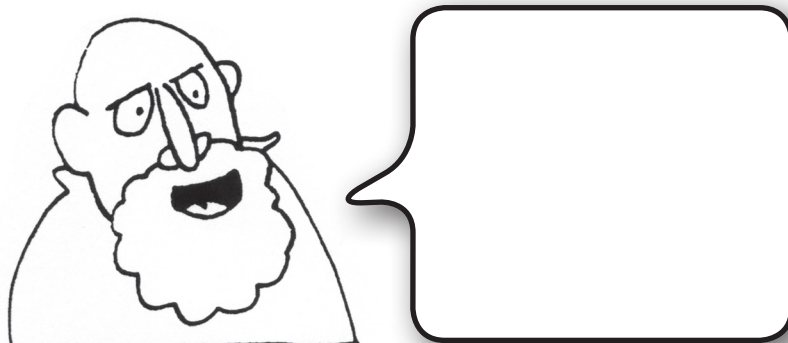
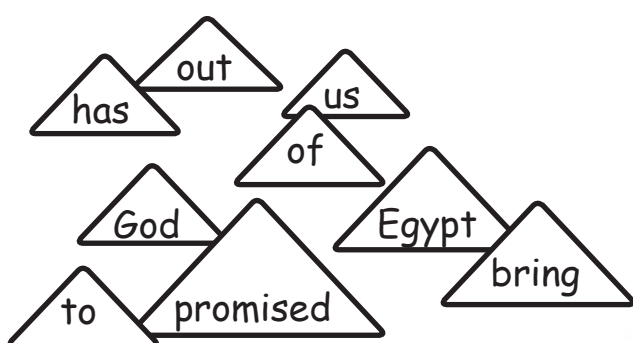
Moses was looking after his father-in-law's sheep and he came to, the mountain of God.

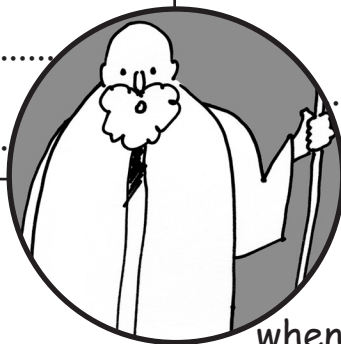

Do you think that *Moses* has forgotten that people were crying in Egypt? Had *God* forgotten? Do you think that he sees when you cry?

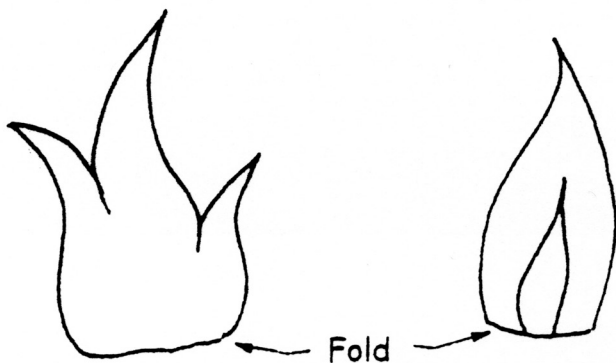
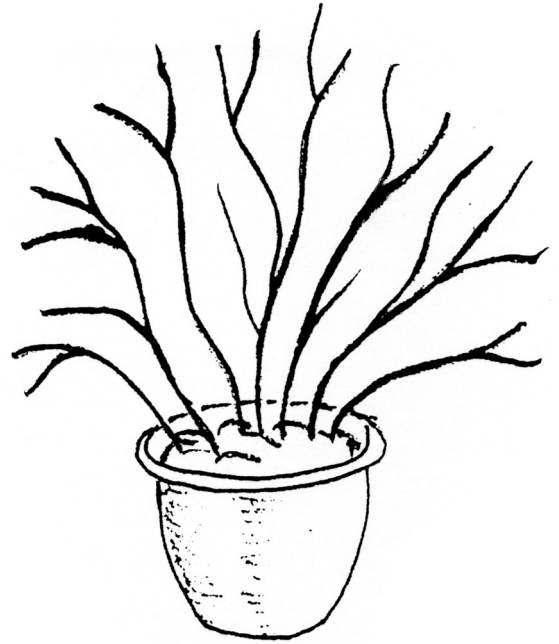
Make a burning bush

Collect a number of small **twigs**

Cut out an egg holder from an **egg box**

Fill it with **playdough**, or plasticene, or something similar

Arrange the twigs in the playdough to resemble a bush



Out of folded orange and red **tissue paper** cut several flame shapes and **glue** them over the branches.
