



Rescuing Jabesh



Saul - the chosen king

You will need:

Cardboard tube, glue, crayons





What to do:

- 1. Cut out the shape around the outline
- 2. Colour the crown and the face
- 3. Colour the beard both sides

- 4. Cut along the lines to make the beard
- 5. Roll the strips of beard round a pencil
- 6. Glue the face and crown round the tube
- 7. Decorate the crown with shiny beads or sequins
