


Elijah is fed by God






Make a raven

You will need:

- Card
- Glue
- Stapler
- Thread
- Scissors
- Black and yellow crayons



1. Glue the body of the bird onto card and cut it out.
2. Cut out the wing shape, place it on folded card and cut it out.
3. Colour the bird and write on the wings "My God will supply all my needs" (Philippians 4 v 19)
4. You may like to cut a slit in the beak and put a small piece of card in it to represent bread.
5. Cut a length of thread, place it under the wings at the fold before fastening the wings to the body.
6. The bird can now be hung up.
