# A gentle whisper

## You will need:

Thin card, mounting adhesive or glue, scissors and an art knife, paper fasteners

## What to do:

1. Stick figures 1, 2 and 3 onto card and cut out.\*
2. Carefully cut out the shaded areas of figure 1.
3. Make a small hole in the centres of each, marked with a small circle.
4. Place the three centres on top of one another with figure 3 at the bottom and figure 2 on top.
5. Use the paper fastener to fix them together.
