

Elisha ... and Jesus


Match the miracles of Elisha with those of Jesus

2 Kings 2 v 19-22




He provided something good to drink.




John 2 v 1-10



You will need:


- Thin card to make the house and room
- Thick card (at least 2 mm thick) to make the steps
- Scissors, crayons and glue




What to do

1. Cut out all the parts on the previous sheet, score along the faint dotted lines, and bend them into block shapes.
2. Fix the tabs and the roof with glue.
3. Mount the house onto a stiff card base. This should have a border of around 6 cm all round the base of the house.




4. Build up the steps at the side of the house using layers of thick card.



5. Fix the small room on top of the roof.

6. Fix the parapet, folding along the dotted



line and glueing into position on the roof edge. The parapet around the steps is not folded but cut and glued to the back and sides of the steps.
