



# Syrians defeated again!

Look in 2 Kings 6 and 7 to find the verses and fill in the blanks.

Sometime after Elisha saw God's army protecting Dothan, .....  
(ch 6 v 24) the King of Syria besieged Samaria. The Israelites were so short  
of food, they even ..... (v 28). The king blamed
