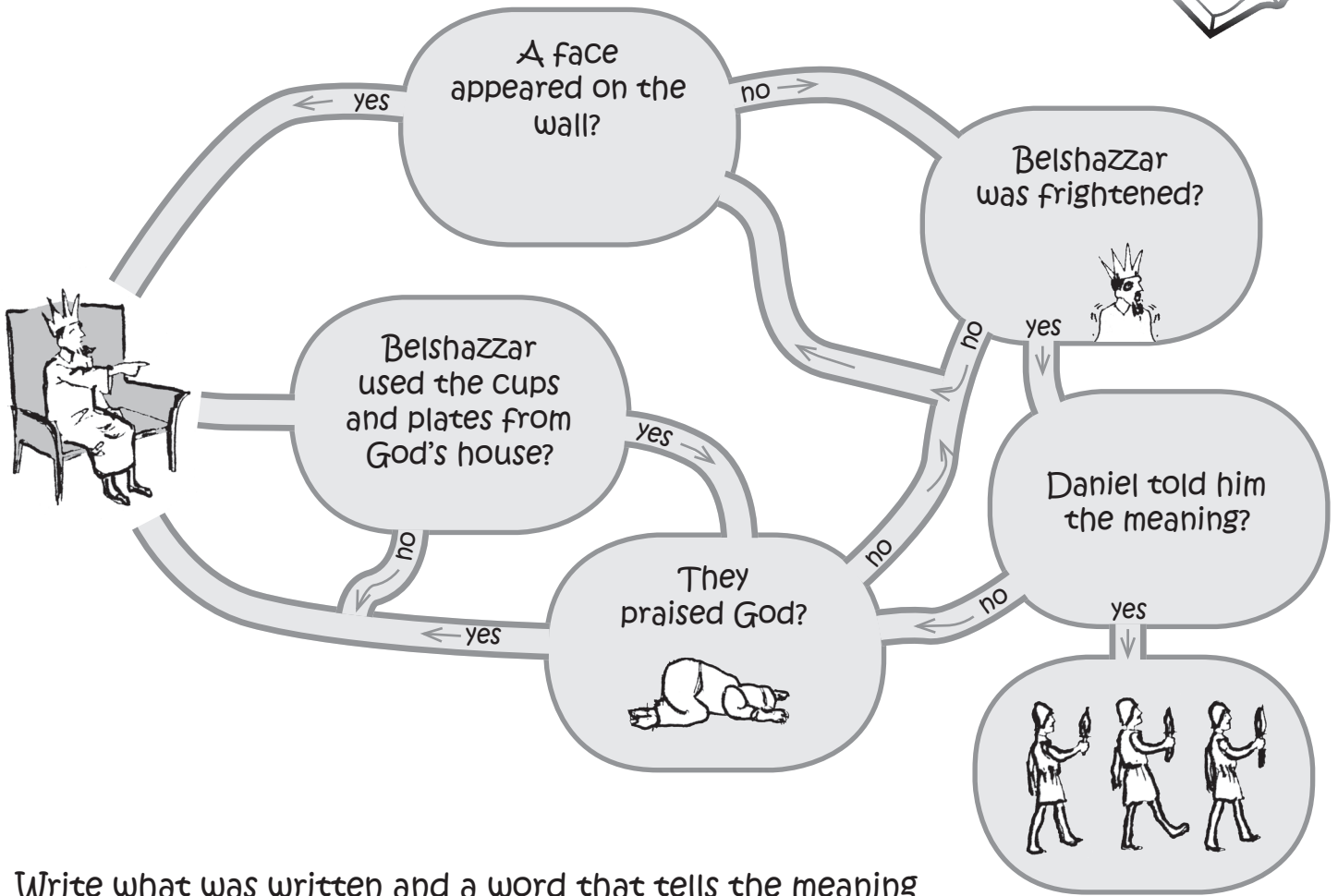

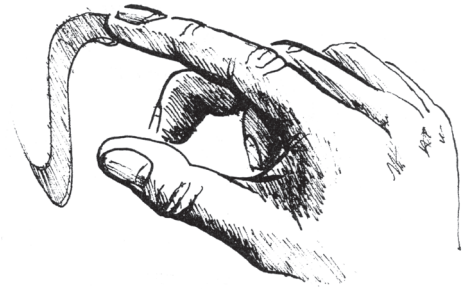

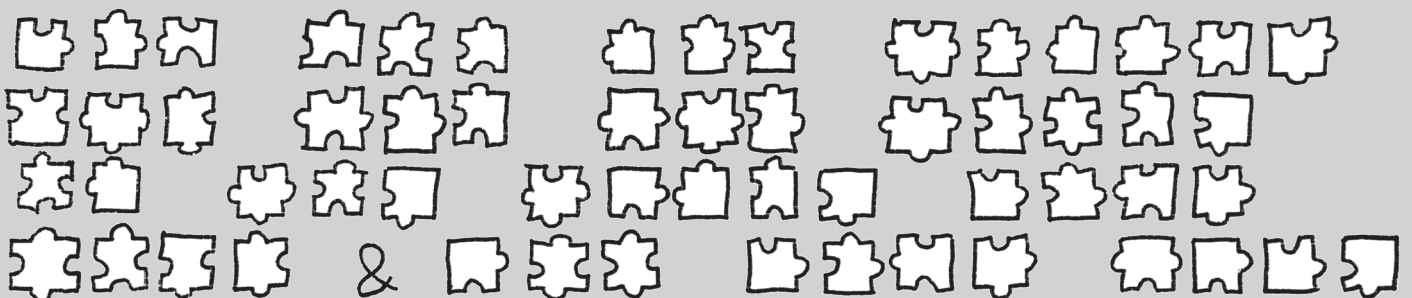

Remember the dream

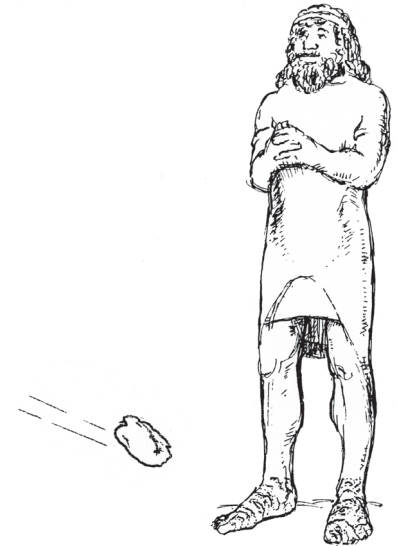
that **Nebuchadnezzar** had?

Look at Daniel 7 v 1-8 and try to draw them. You might find it impossible!



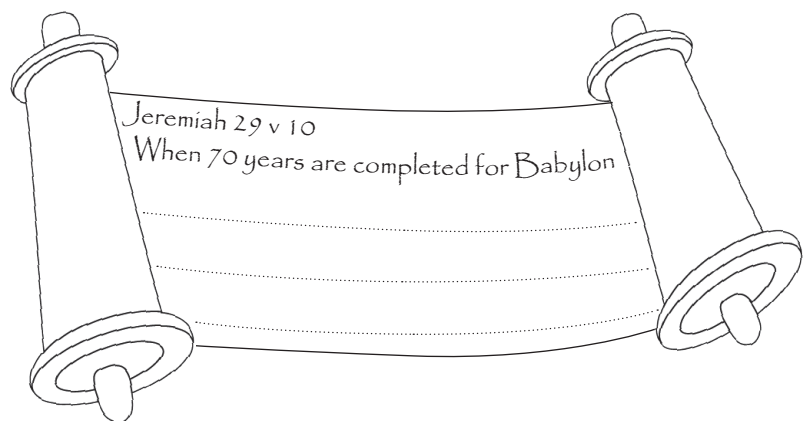
Now the good news!

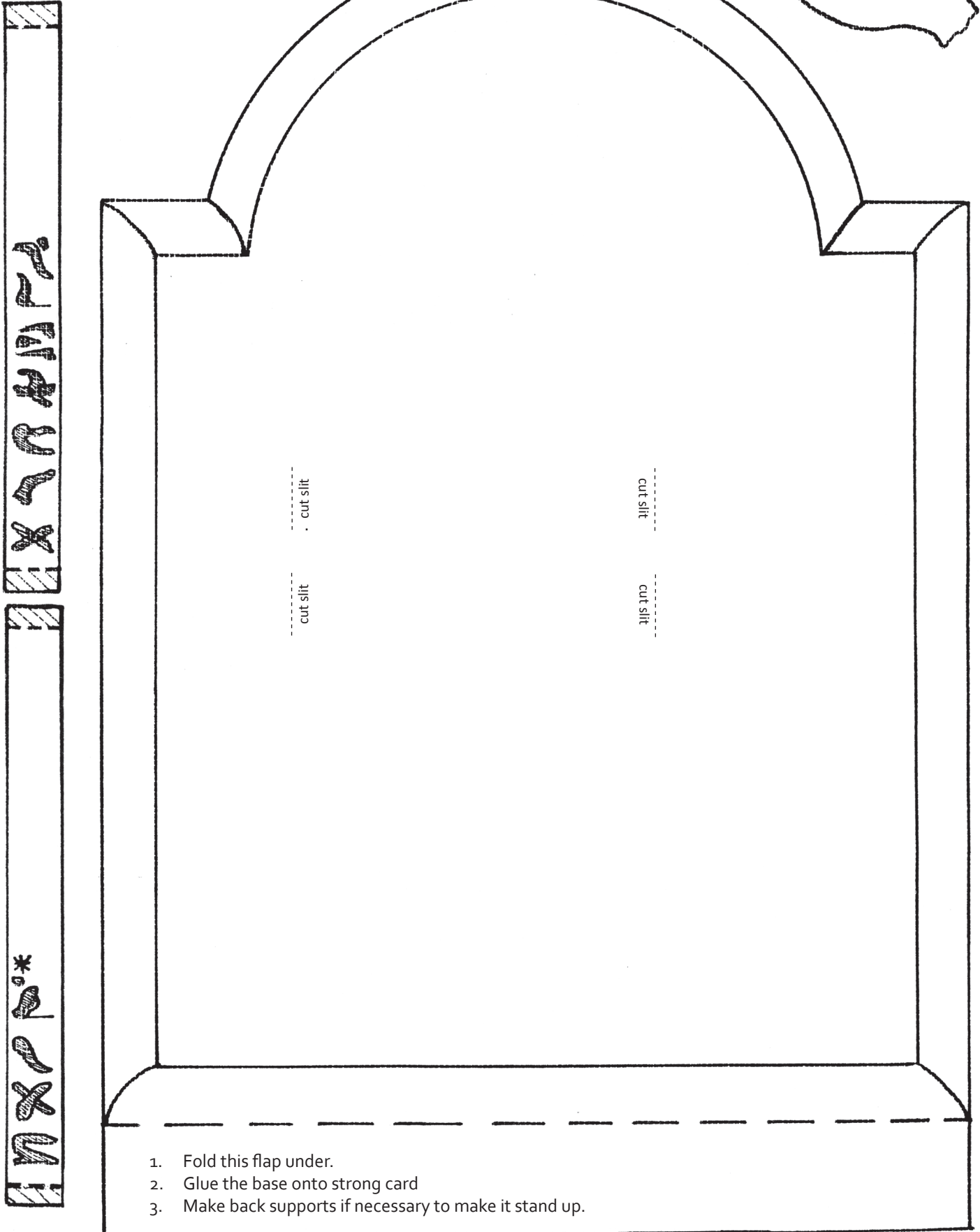
