





## Make Daniel and the lions


#### You will need:


Thin coloured card – orange, yellow, brown and blue (15 cm x 12 cm).

### To make Daniel:

- 1. Fold blue card in half lengthways and place template of Daniel's robe with dotted line along the fold. Draw round and cut it off.
- 2. Cut hair and beard from brown card.
- 3. Cut out face and glue onto top part of beard.

4. Slide face and beard into the two slots at the top of the partially folded robe. Cut out the hands and glue to the base of the sleeves.





## To make a lion:

1. Fold a 11 cm x 11 cm piece of yellow card in half diagonally and place template of lion's body with dotted line along the fold. Draw round and cut it out.

2. Cut out mane in orange and fringe the edge.

3. Cut lion's head from same colour as the body, glue head in centre of mane and fasten mane in place on the body.
