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
Now ... fit the words into the grid so that Jesus' command to the storm fits down the middle.

Psalm 65 is a psalm of praise to God.


Verse 7 says God

Think of trouble (turmoil or tumult) amongst people and nations. You may need to look in a newspaper or ask an adult.




