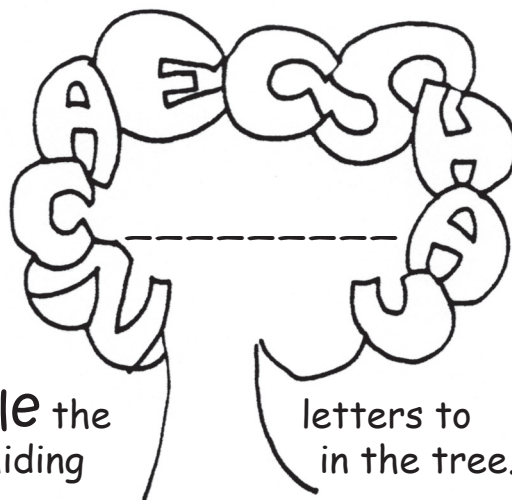


# Zacchaeus

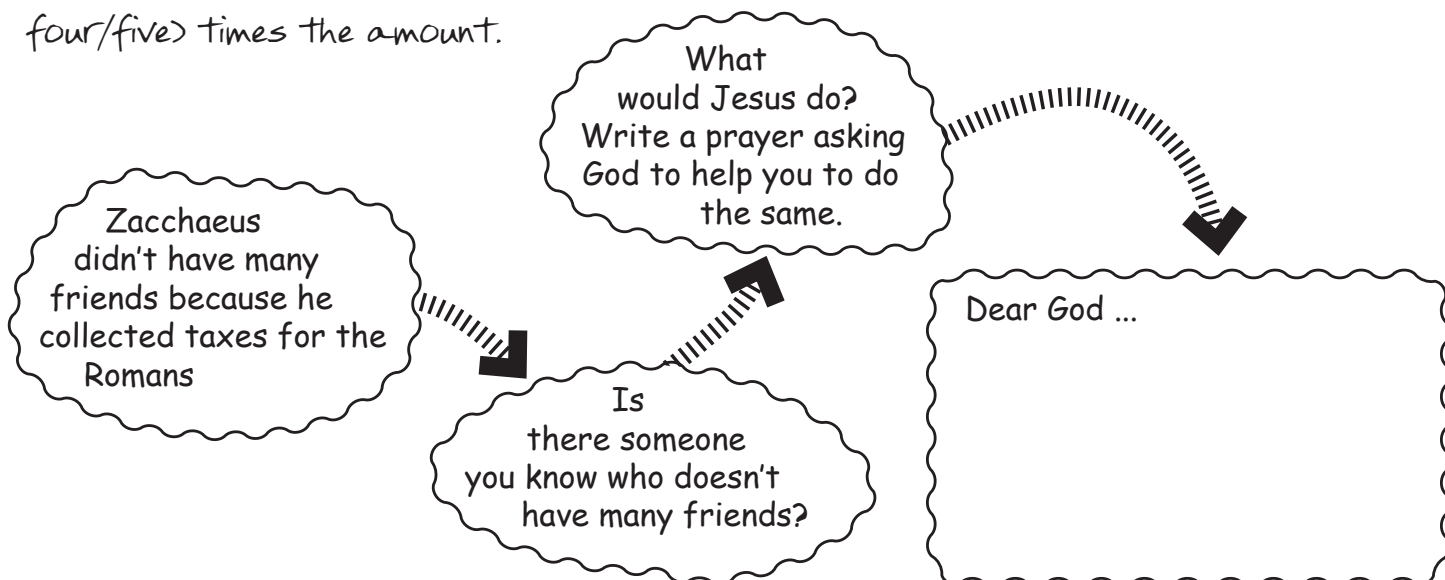
Put a ring round the correct word or words to tell the story.

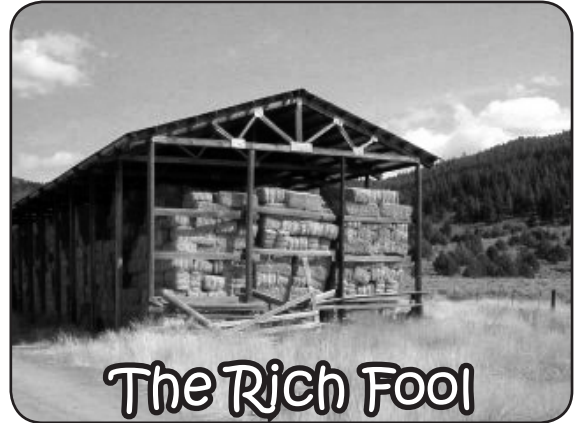
