

1. A4 card
2. Glue

## What to do:

1. Cut out the cockerel and stick onto card, or print onto card from [www.cssu.org.uk/oljn4.htm](http://www.cssu.org.uk/oljn4.htm).
2. Tear magazine pages into feathers (choose colours that will go together).
3. Stick small feathers onto head and neck, larger ones onto the tail.
4. Finish with feather shapes to give movement to the tail.
