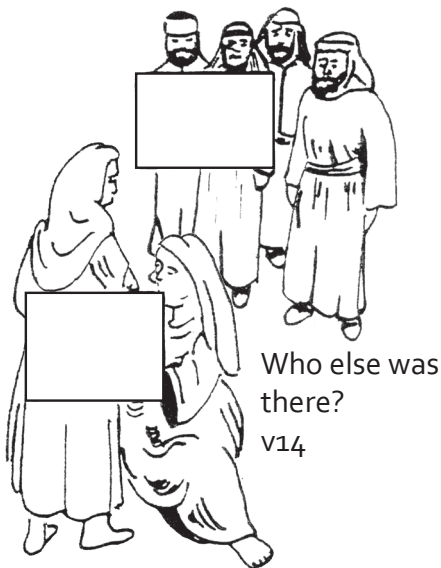
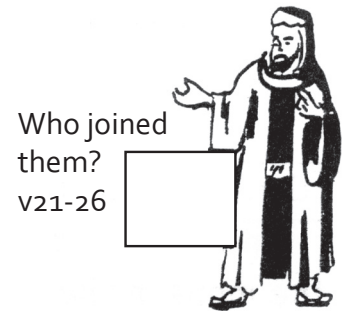
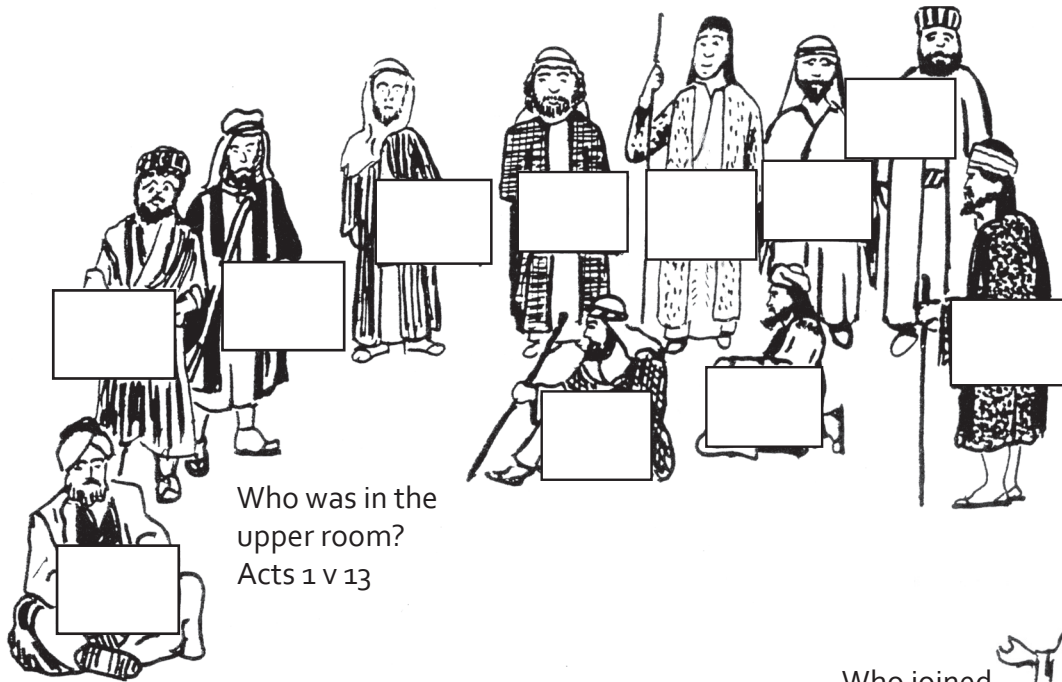
Find Jerusalem and all the other places the people came from who heard the disciples in their own language. You will need a Bible and some maps.

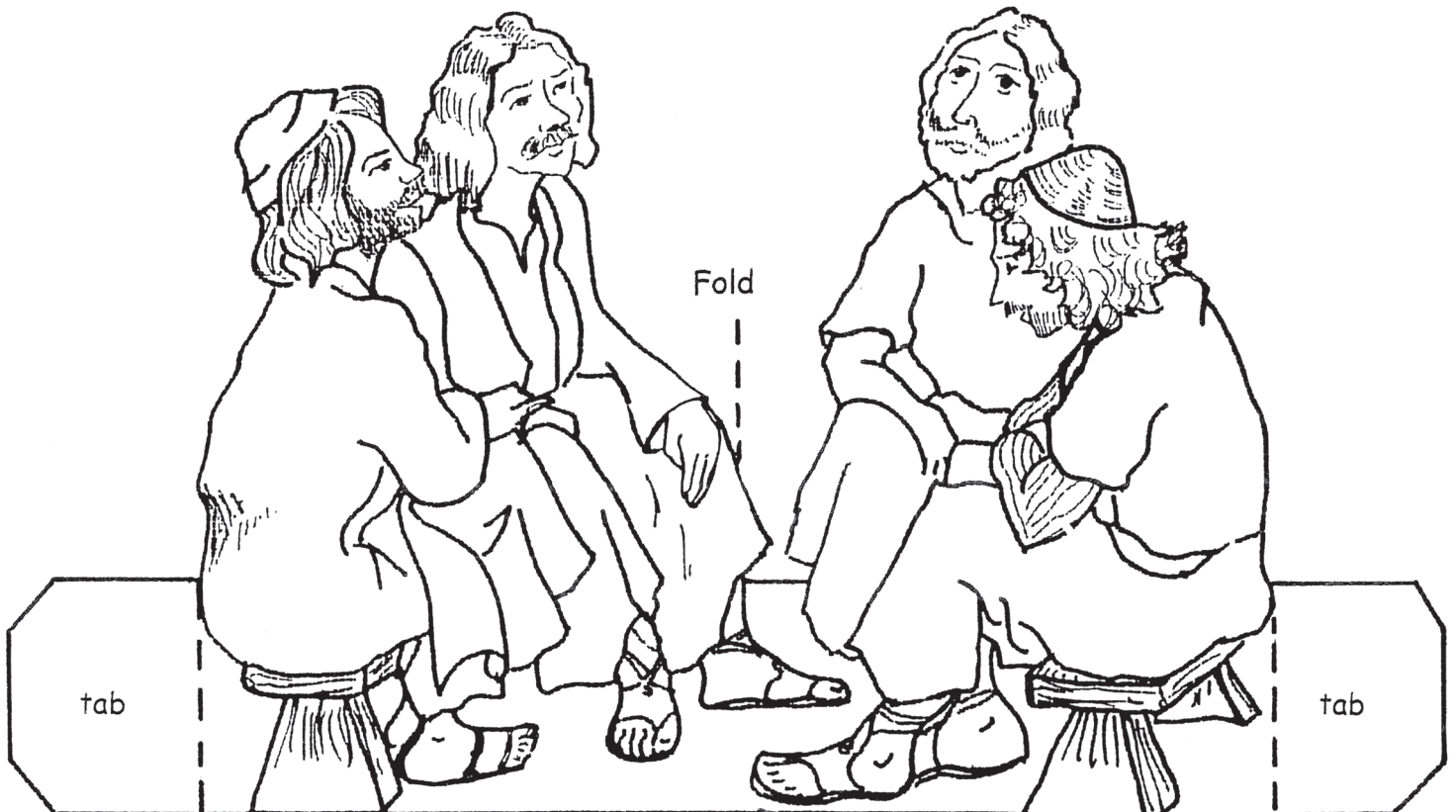
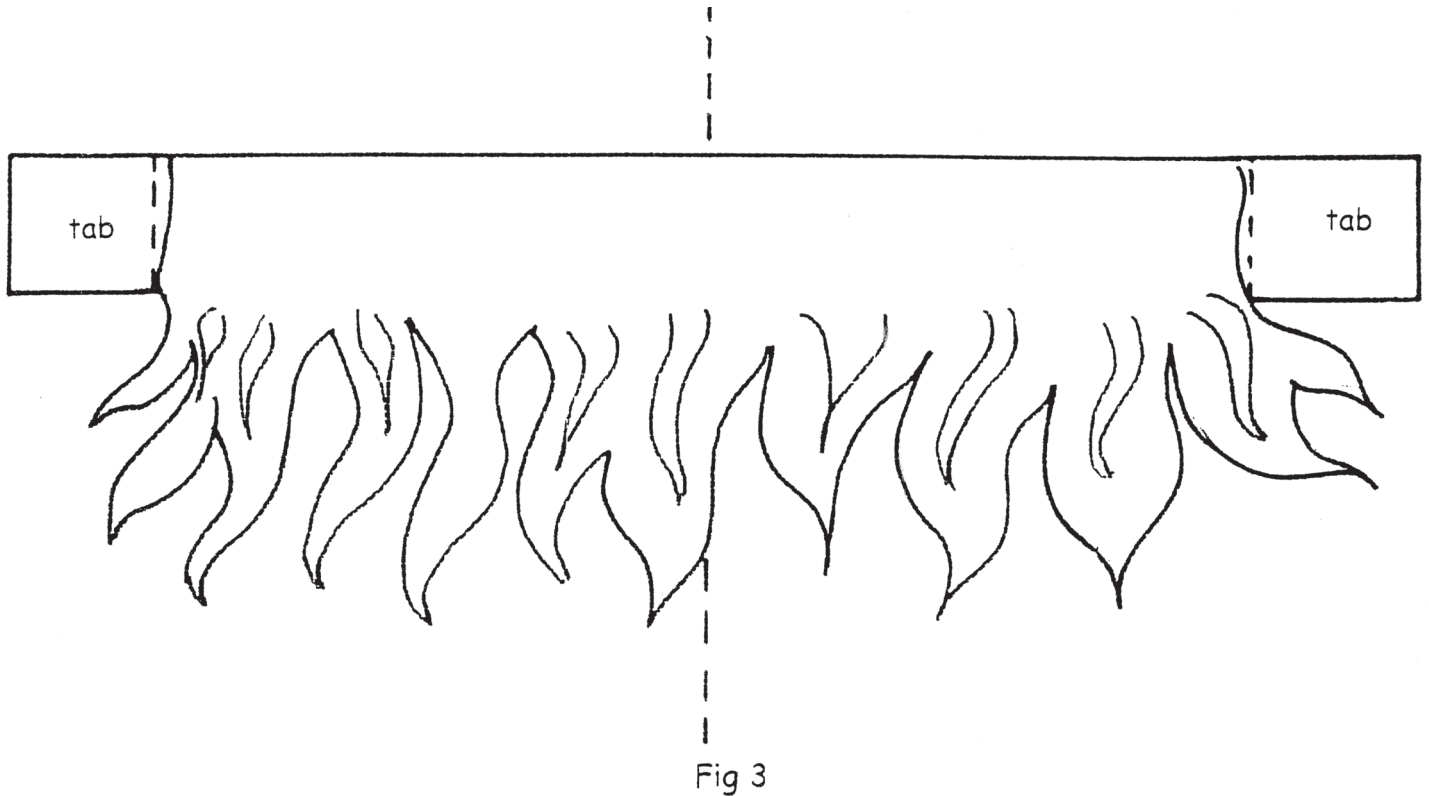


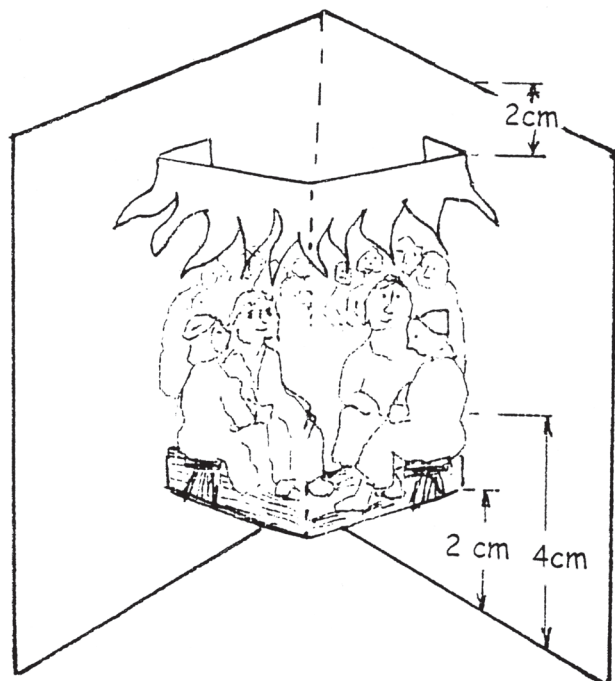

What to do:

1. Take a sheet of A4 (or similar) card and fold it down the middle. The other parts of the picture will be stuck to the inside.
2. Cut out figure 1 (or you can print onto card from www.cssu.org.uk/oljn4.htm) and colour it.
3. Glue it inside the card matching the fold to the dotted line and placing the base of the picture 4 cm from the bottom of the card.



4. Cut out figure 2 and colour it. Mountain fold* this picture along the dotted line. Fold the tabs to the back and stick them into position matching the fold line, and with the base of the picture 2 cm from the bottom of the card.
5. Cut out figure 3 and colour it.
6. Mountain fold the centre of the fire along the dotted line.
7. Fold the tabs to the back and stick the tabs in position above the people with the top of the fire about 2 cm from the top of the card, matching the mountain fold with the fold in the card.
8. Pull the two moving parts forward as you close the card. When you open the card you should have a stand up picture card.



* 'Mountain fold' simply means that with the card folded the picture is on the outside.
