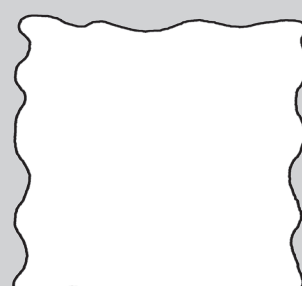
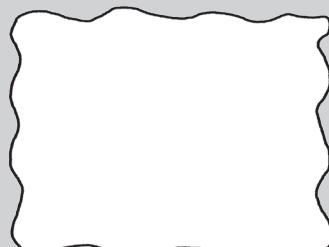
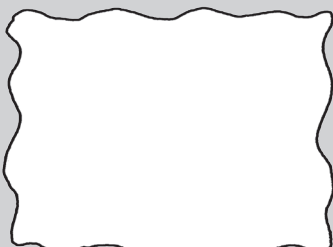
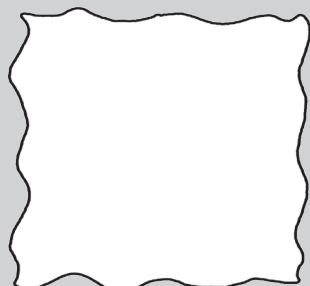
What do you think that verse means?

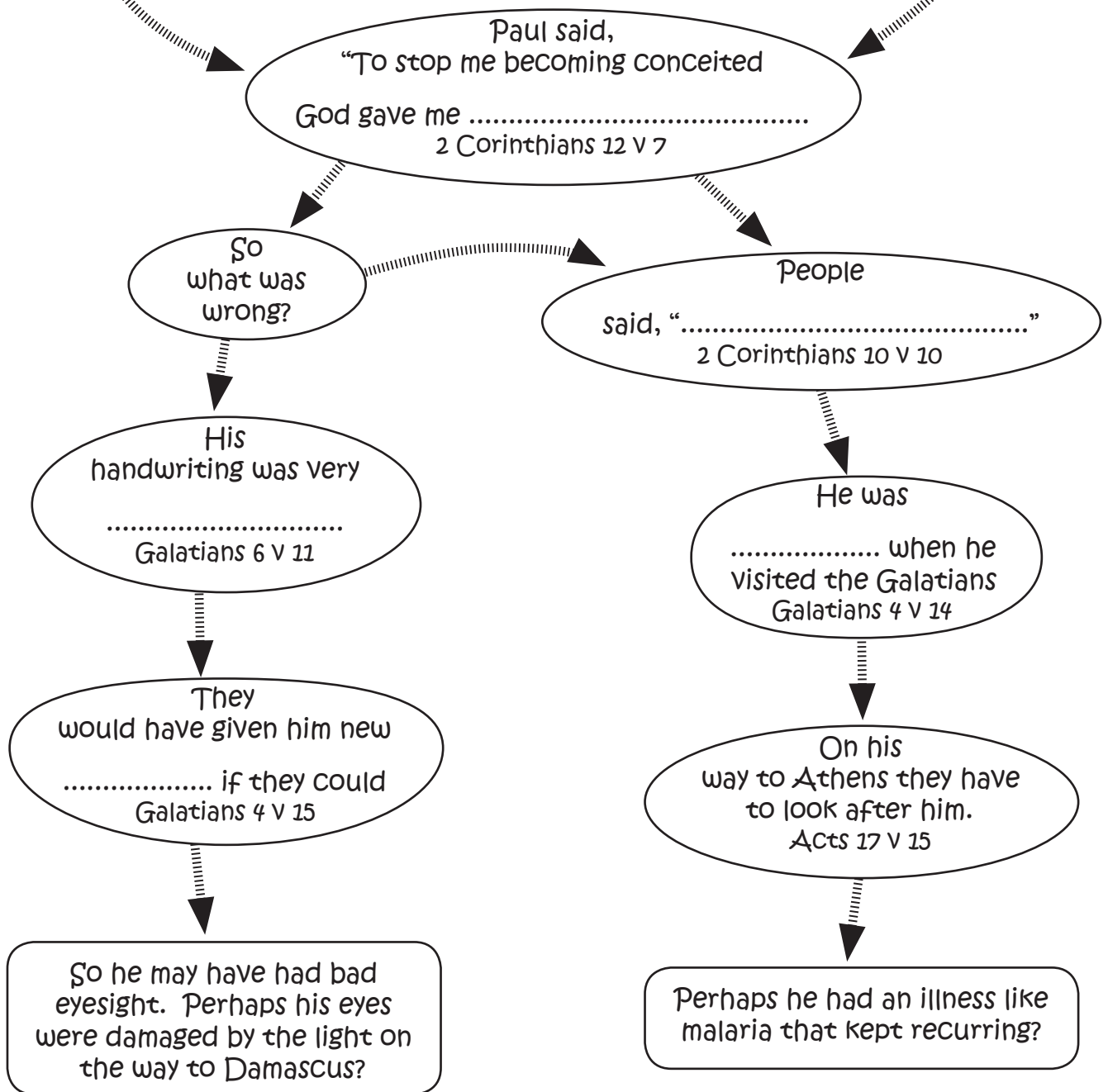
A verse to colour and remember (Acts 17 v 27)
