



The start of the journey is in Acts
18 v 23. Paul went from Antioch
through Galatia and Phrygia to
Ephesus. He spent

Corinth. Then he went back the way
he had come, to Troas and Ephesus,
then by sea south of Cyprus, to
Jerusalem (Acts 21 v 17).
