Activities and Games

Activity 1 Six up! (25 mins)

Aim

To re-visit some of the people, places and events in John's gospel

Equipment Needed

- 1 set of cards – cut up and shuffled
- 2 'joker' cards

Instructions

1. Divide into 2 teams. Each team needs a team captain.
2. Team 1 takes the first card and reads the first clue but not the subject at the top.
3. Team 2 tries to guess the subject, speaking only through the team captain. They are only allowed 1 guess per clue. If they guess is correct, they score the number of points by that clue. If it is incorrect team 1 reads them the next clue.
4. This continues until either the team guess correctly or until the end of the card, in which case it is discarded.
5. Once the card has been guessed/finished, it is the turn of the other team.
6. Play alternates between the teams until the cards are finished.

Scoring – for a correct guess the team is awarded the number by the side of the last clue. If the card is not guessed then there is no score for that turn. There is an opportunity to use a joker and earn more points.

Using the joker - For bonus points, teams can try to double their points by using their 'joker' card. This reverses the rules so that they are read the subject at the top of the card but not the clues. The team then have 2 minutes to come up with the 7 clues that they think will appear on the card. For each clue they correctly guess they earn 2 points – and so a maximum of 12 points. The joker can be used only once, at any point of the game.

Tip - Where possible, the clues are based on the chapters used in the lessons rather than general passages.


6. Through me you can see the power of Jesus

Activity 2 Silence (20 mins)

Aims

To review some of the key people and events in the early ministry of Jesus and to consider how different people might react to one another

Equipment Needed

- concordances or list of references relating to each character
- pens
- paper
- pack of character cards cut up and shuffled

Instructions

1. Hand a character card to each student which they must make sure no-one else can see.
2. Explain that they have 5 minutes to remind themselves about that character using the concordances or the references you have prepared.
3. After the preparation time, arrange the seats in a circle and the students take it in turns to mime something their character might do, for example, Peter may want to leave his fishy smelling overcoat by the door or the man who was blind may stare at everything with wonder.
4. If those in the circle think they know who it is they can write it down on their piece of paper. No one guesses out loud.
5. When everyone has mimed their character, the students have a chance to choose one of the characters and mime a reaction to him or her. They might go up to 'John the baptist' and show that they want to be baptised. If they are right 'John' will respond accordingly.
6. At any time the students can add to or change their guesses.
7. When you think everyone has had a chance to guess or be guessed you can discuss the answers and the students can explain why they acted or reacted the way they did.
