Not enough grazing land for Abram and for Lot! What's to be done? Read Genesis 13:1-7 and identify the problem, and how it arose.



Digging Deeper - What happened to Lot?

Genesis 14 tells how there was a battle between four kings from round the Rivers of Tigris and Euphrates (where Abram and Lot had come from) and five kings from round Sodom where Lot lived now.

Read verses 10-12 to find out who won and what the four kings did with Lot. Then read verses 13 -16 to find out what Abram did.

What, in verse 14, makes you think Abram was a wealthy man? Read 17-20 to find out who Melchizedek was, what he brought and what he said.

The whole story of what happened to Sodom is in chapter 18:16-19:29 but

Genesis 18:20 particularly says what God thought of the people of Sodom and 19:24-29 says what happened to it and to Lot later.
