

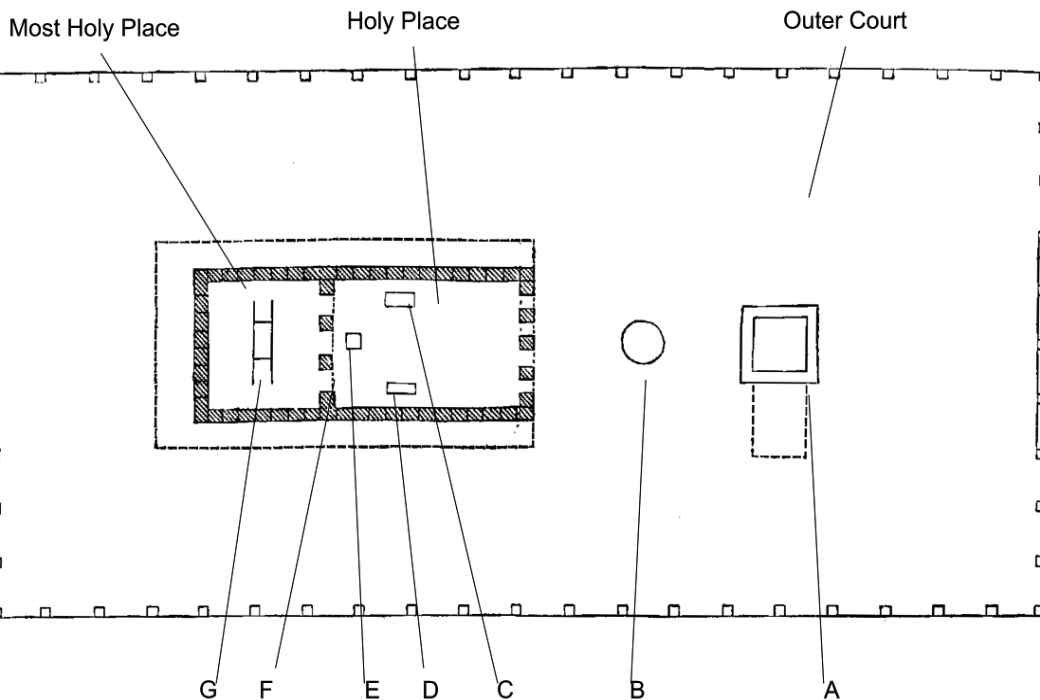

## Digging Deeper - the Pentateuch

The first 5 books of the Bible are sometimes called the Pentateuch. Try to find out why and try to find out who wrote them.

**Genesis** means 'beginnings'. What beginnings are in Genesis?

These may help you: Genesis 1:1; 2:7; 9:1; 10:1; 11:1-7; 32:28.

You may think of more

**Exodus** means 'going out'. You know where they were going out from. You may remember from Digging Deeper in lesson 16 who else came out from Egypt?

**Leviticus** Exodus 32:26-29 tells us who God entrusted with being priests and why. Look through Leviticus in a Bible with headings to the chapters and decide why the book has got this name.

**Numbers** Look at Numbers 1:2 and chapter 26 (Numbers 2:32 tells you how many men of fighting age there were. There would have been about the same number of women of that age and probably about 800,000 Levites and old and young people. So you can try to estimate how about many people may have come out of Egypt)

**Deuteronomy** means 'second telling of the law'. Look through the first few chapters to see what Moses is reminding the people about. In Deuteronomy 7:7-8 he reminds them of a very special message.
