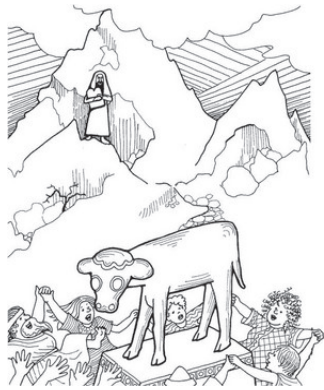


Exodus 33, 34

The Glory of God

What would you expect 'glory' to be like? Can you think of any examples of people who have achieved 'glory' by winning medals or prizes?

Moses had already seen the glory of God in different ways - look at Exodus 14:17-18; 16:7; 24:16-17. But he realised that there was still more to learn.

God reveals his glory

Look at Exodus 34:4 - 8, and see how God describes himself

The LORD, the LORD, the (1) and God,
(2), abounding in (3)
....., maintaining (4)to thousands,
and (5) wickedness, rebellion and sin.
Yet (6)he punishes the children
and their children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation.
