
Joshua – God prepares a leader

Exodus 1-20 Numbers 13-14 Be strong and conrageous. Do not be terrified; do not be disconraged; for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go. Joshua 1:9

We learn from the things which happen to us in our lives. God uses events in our lives to teach us lessons and to prepare us for things which we will need to do in the future. We can see this in the life of Joshua.

Forty years of preparation

Think about how Joshua had watched God working all the time they had travelled through the wilderness. What would he have learned from his experiences as they travelled?





How do you think these incidents prepared Joshua for his task of leading the Israelites?

Can you think of any ways in which God is preparing you for your life?

Think about it: was Joshua the only one who went through the experiences in the wilderness?

How did he react differently to the things that happened? What does that tell us about Joshua?

Do you think you need to learn to react in any particular way to the things which happen to you?

Be strong and courageous

Read Joshua 1:1-9. How many times does God tell Joshua to be 'strong and courageous'.

What reasons does he give?

Do you remember what the spies had said about the land they had to try and conquer? Numbers 13:25-33. Would it be easy for Joshua?

What strange instruction did God give to Joshua when as a military leader he would be thinking about how to be successful in capturing the land? Joshua 1:8

What can we learn from this?
