Digging Deeper

The book of the Law that Josiah's men found was written by Moses (It may have been the first 5 books of our Bible or it may have just been the things that Moses learnt on the mountain). Look at Deuteronomy 31:24-26 to read about Moses giving the book of the Law to the Israelites.

Why was Josiah so worried when he read it? Deuteronomy 28:58-61.

Look through Deuteronomy 28 after verse 15 to see some of the curses that God was saying would happen to the people.

What should Josiah have been made to do when he became king and throughout his life? Deuteronomy 17:18-20

What do we know about the Bible we have? 2 Peter 1:20-21

Do you think we should read it regularly like the kings were expected to? 2 Timothy 3:16

God doesn't tell us to copy the Bible out but perhaps learning verses occasionally would be a good way of keeping it in our minds.

Do your friends know that you think the Bible makes a difference to your life?

If they don't, make sure you tell them this week all about it.

Look in 2 Chronicles 35:23-37 to find out who attended Josiah's funeral. What do you think they would have said to pay tribute to him?
