20:1-2; 9:23-24**

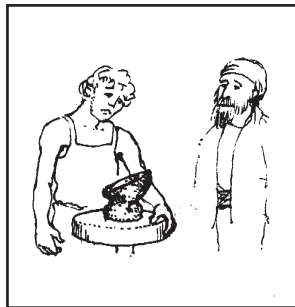
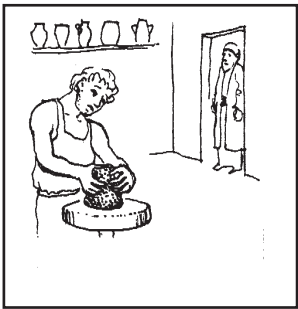
