

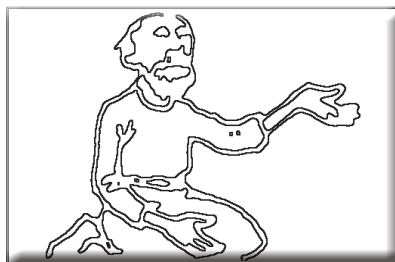
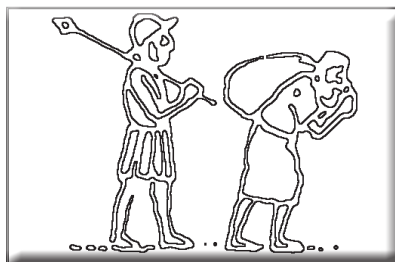
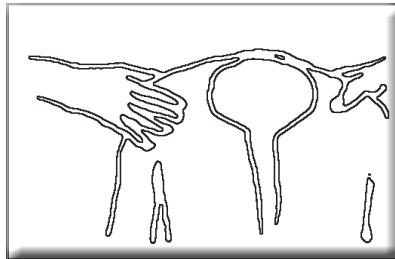
Matthew 5:38-48, 7:1-5

You have heard that 20 across was said: "12 across for 12 across, and tooth for tooth." But I tell you, 9 down 23 across 7 across an evil person.

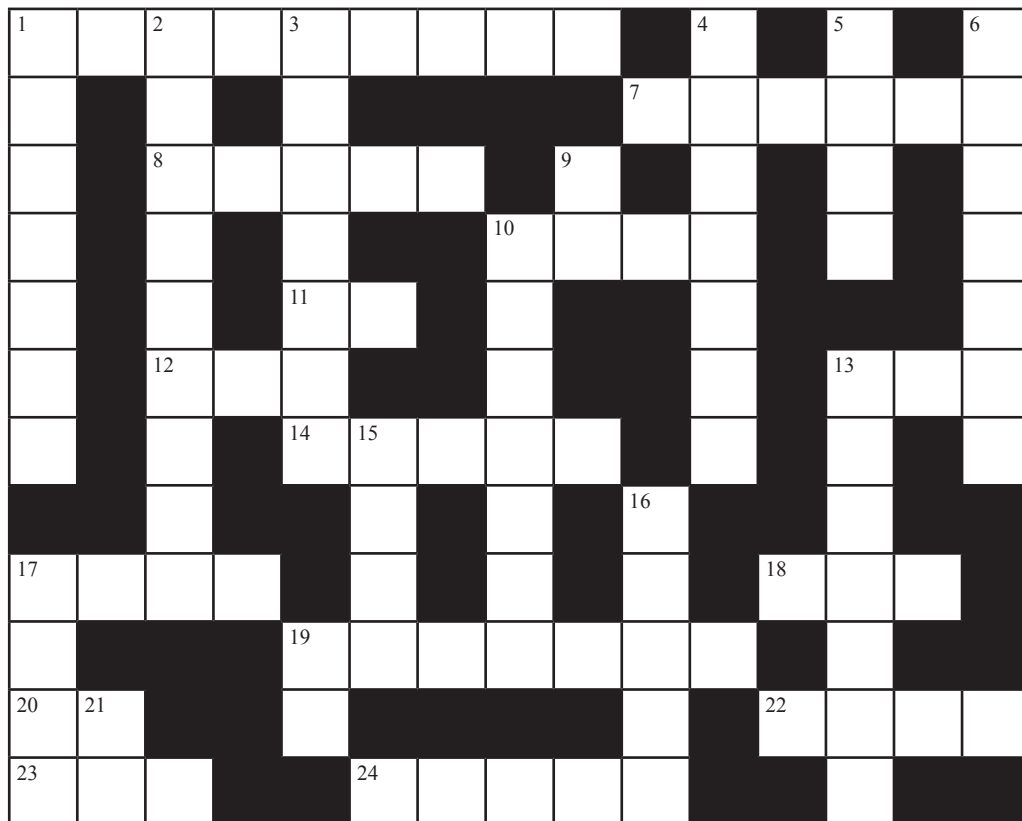
