


Philippians 4:8








## Digging Deeper

## **Ephesus**

Ephesus was a splendid and wealthy city with a harbour, gymnasiums, a stadium and baths as well as the theatre and temples to gods and goddesses.

Later in Paul's life he wrote to the Christians at Ephesus in which he wanted to show them what real riches were.

Read Ephesians 1:7-8 and 18 and decide what the riches of a Christian are. How are these riches given? Chapter 2:4 tells us what God is rich in.
