

11 The Kingdom of God - The Olivet Prophecy

The disciples asked two questions, though they may not have realised how separate they were:

- Q1 When will the temple be destroyed?
- Q2 What signs will there be of Jesus' coming and of the end of the world?

The temple was destroyed by the Romans in AD 70 following a terrible war, but we still await the fulfilment of the second part - the return of Christ to the earth. Jesus answers both questions, but it is not always clear which of his words apply to which question. It is worth trying to understand how his answers apply, however, as a pattern emerges which can be helpful.

One of the Old Testament tests for a prophet was whether his prophecy came true. This was not much help to the prophet's contemporaries if the prophecy took 1000 years to be fulfilled. That may explain why many prophecies had a short term fulfilment as well as a long term one,
