



# Acrostic

## Did you Know?

John ate locusts and wild honey. We often eat honey but have you ever eaten a locust?

• You can buy them to eat in shops in the Netherlands and over the internet but they are mostly eaten in Africa.

- They can be deep fried, stir fried, roasted, or covered with chocolate!
- A locust contains 18g protein and 21.5g fat.
- The newly hatched ones are soft but most are crunchy.
- The taste is something between chicken, toasted sunflower seeds and prawns.
- Like when you eat a jelly baby, you have to decide whether to begin by eating the head or the legs. If you choose to start with the six little legs you need to fold them in otherwise they will trail out of your mouth! After that, you eat the abdomen and finally (gulp) the head. Crunch, crunch, swallow.
