Activity 1: You To Choose

Aim

To review the lessons through playing a multiple choice game.

Equipment needed

- You To Choose board game, photocopied and enlarged if possible
- Dice
- One counter per child
- · Set of You To Choose questions.

Instructions

Take turns to go round the board game by throwing the dice in the usual way. When a player lands on a square they are asked the question which corresponds to that number, and have to say which of the answers is correct. If they are right, they can move on next go. If they are wrong, they have to move back one space and answer that question before they can move on.

Activity 2: Matching Pairs – Who did what?

Aim

To revise the lessons by matching the names of people with descriptions of what happened to them.

Equipment needed

Matching Pairs cards, enlarged if possible, mounted on the same colour card and cut out

Instructions

Shuffle the cards and place them face down on the table. Take it in turns to turn over 2 cards. If they match keep them and have another turn. If they don't match turn they back over and the next player has a turn. The winner has the most pairs.

The blank set of cards is for the children to extend the game by thinking up their own names and descriptions of other Bible characters.


