Activities and Games

Activity 1: Follow in Jesus' footsteps

Aim

To complete the game by moving forward and back as indicated.

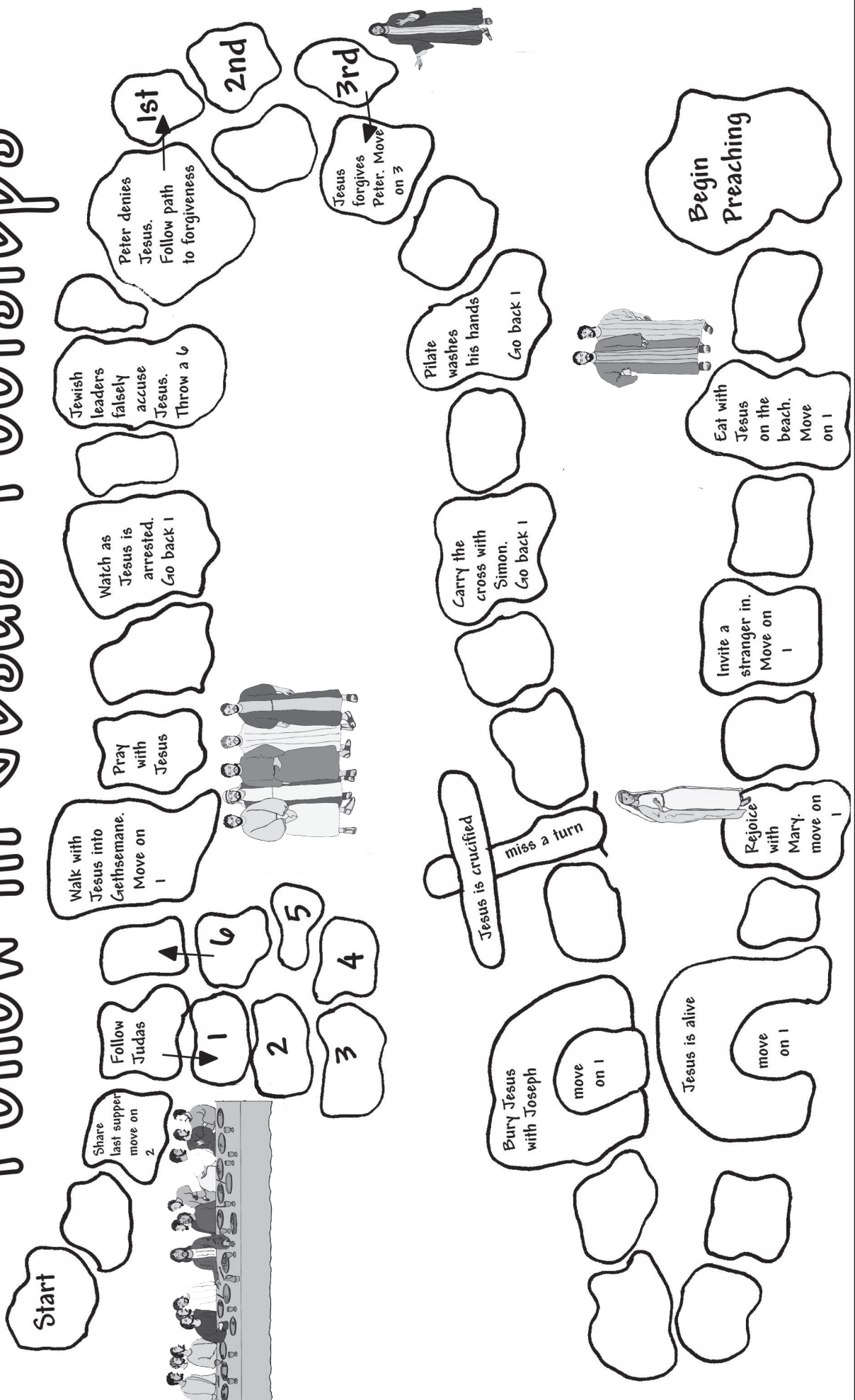
Equipment

- Board game, photocopied and enlarged if possible (print onto card from website - some printers will enlarge with 'Poster Printing')
- Dice
- Counters

Instructions

- Take it in turns to move round the board, throwing the dice to find how many spaces to move in each go. Follow the instructions on the board.
- When landing on Judas' stepping stone, follow the numbered stones one at a time, on six consecutive turns without rolling the dice.
- When landing on Peter's stepping stone of denial, follow the numbered stones one at a time on three consecutive turns without rolling the dice. On the next turn step onto the next stone and move on three. If a player lands on the 'forgiveness' stone without stepping on the 'denial' stone, don't move on three.
- The winner is the first to begin preaching.

Activity 2: Blockbuster Quiz

Aim

To assess how well the children remember the stories from this unit

Equipment

- Blockbuster grid (print onto card from website - some printers will enlarge with 'Poster Printing')
- Blockbuster Question sheet
- 2 different coloured pens

Instructions

- Divide the class into 2 teams. One team starts at the left hand side and the other team at the right hand side of the blockbuster grid. Team 1 chooses a letter from their starting side to begin.
- Ask them a question which corresponds with that letter and, if answered correctly, they can colour that hexagon in. If answered incorrectly don't give the correct answer as Team 2 may use that square later. To assess individual knowledge ask the children to answer individually within their team. Play passes to Team 2.
- Continue playing as teams, to work their way across the board colouring a path. The teams can only choose letters which are adjacent to ones which their team has coloured in.
- The winning team is the one who gets across to the other side first.
- At the end of the quiz, if there is time, go back and talk about questions which were not covered in the game or ones they got wrong.

Blockbuster Questions

- J – the disciple who betrayed Jesus (Judas)
T – the number of silver coins paid for Jesus' betrayal (thirty)
P – the Jewish feast at the time of the last supper (Passover)
S – the man who carried Jesus' cross (Simon of Cyrene)
H – the man to whom Pilate sent Jesus to for another trial (Herod)
A – the comfort Jesus received in the garden (angel)
T – the crown they placed on Jesus' head was made of this (thorns)
G – the quiet place where Jesus went to pray (Gethsemane)
P – the disciple who became angry when Jesus was arrested (Peter)
N – the time the trial of Jesus took place (night)
F – the disciples did this when Jesus was taken away (fled)
A – what the women were going to do to Jesus' body (anoint)
C – the creature that showed Peter he had denied his Lord (cock crowing)
W – Peter did this when he realised he had denied Christ (wept)
E – people said Jesus was calling out for this person from the cross (Elijah)
P – the man who wanted to set Jesus free (Pilate)
B – the man released to the Jews instead of Jesus (Barabas)
L – the soldiers cast these for Jesus' clothes (lots)
C – this was torn in half in the temple (curtain)
G – the place where Jesus was crucified (Golgotha)
J – the man who asked for Jesus' body (Joseph of Arimathea)
R – this blocked the entrance to Jesus' tomb (rock)
G – Pilate placed this around the tomb (guard)
J – the disciple who looked in the tomb and believed (John)
M – the first person the risen Lord appeared to (Mary Magdalene)
T – the disciple who was not there when the Lord first appeared (Thomas)
E – the village 2 disciples were travelling to when they saw Christ (Emmaus)
E – Jesus did this to show he was not a ghost (eat)
A – this was who told Mary the Lord was not in the tomb (angel)
P – Jesus did this before giving his disciples the bread and wine (pray)
G – where Jesus said he would see his disciples after his resurrection (Galilee)
S – Jesus' disciples did this as Jesus prayed in Gethsemane (slept)
K – Judas betrayed Jesus with this (kiss)
F – Jesus called Judas this even when he betrayed him (friend)
C – the high priest at the time of Jesus' arrest (Caiaphas)
