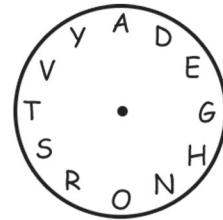

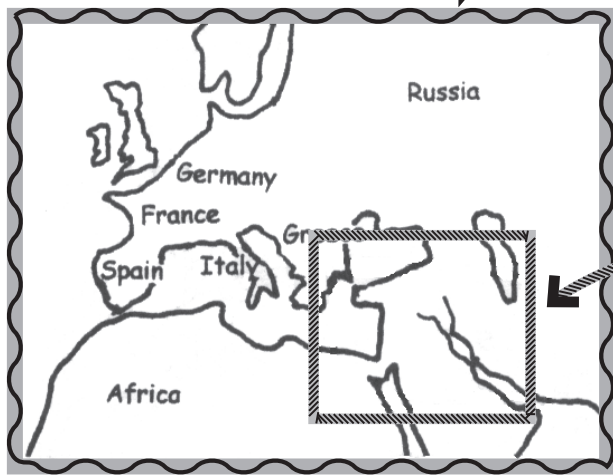

Have you been to any of these countries or heard about them in the news?

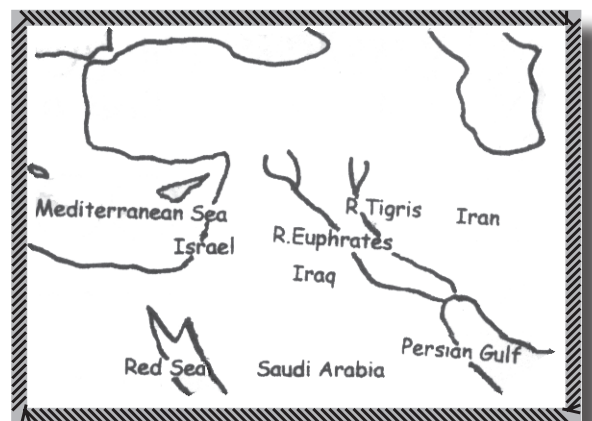
These two shapes show the same part of the world.

You will learn about the Garden of Eden next week.

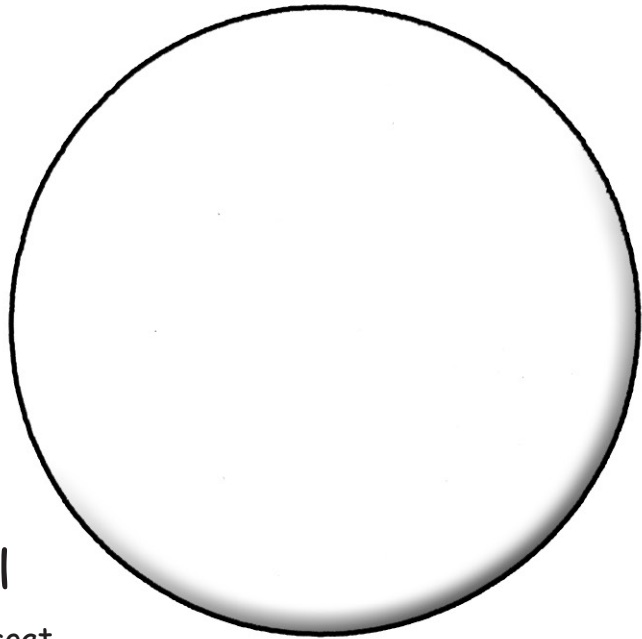
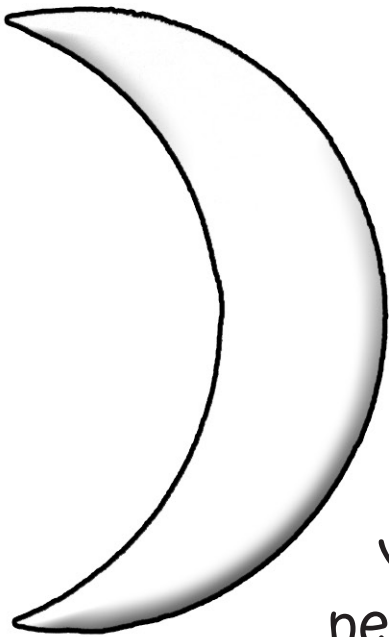

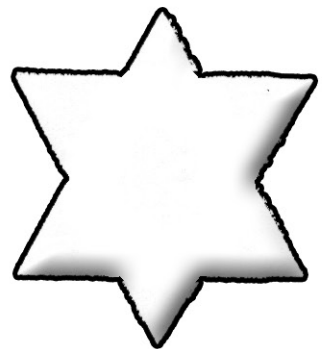
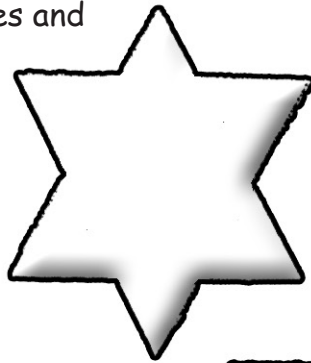
Sunday	Genesis 1	verses 1-5
