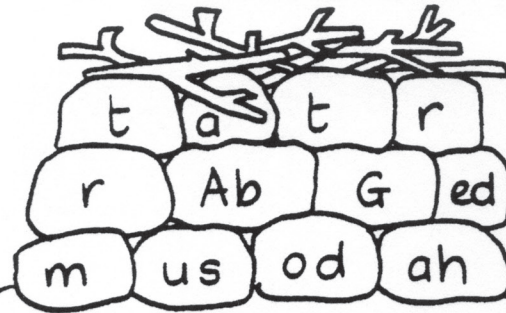

Lesson 8 - Now something harder ...

If we want to find out some more about a verse in the Bible we can use REFERENCES.
Not all Bibles are the same, but references are usually something like this.

Genesis 22 2 And he said, Take now thy son, thine only ^a son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah ^b ; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I tell thee of.	^a John 3:16 ^b 2 Chron 3:1

The little 'a' by the words 'only son' shows us there may be something interesting in John chapter 3 v 16, and the little 'b' by the word 'Moriah' shows us that there may be something else in 2 Chronicles chapter 3 v 1.

John 3 16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

2 Chronicles 3 1 Then Solomon began to build the house of the LORD at Jerusalem in mount Moriah, where the LORD appeared unto David his father, in the place that David had prepared in the threshingfloor ^x of Ornan the Jebusite	^x 2 Sam 24:18

Now there is a little 'x' by the word 'threshing-floor', which tells us there is more to find out in 2 Samuel chapter 24 v 18.

2 Samuel 24 18 And Gad came that day to David, and said unto him, Go up, rear an altar unto the LORD in the threshingfloor of Araunah [or Ornan] the Jebusite.

So ... we have learnt ...

1. In the same way as Abram was prepared to offer Isaac, God offered his son.
2. The place where Abram was going to sacrifice Isaac became Jerusalem and King Solomon built the temple there.
3. Also, King David had built an altar on the same spot.
4. References in the margin of a Bible can be really interesting and can help us to understand what God is saying to us.
