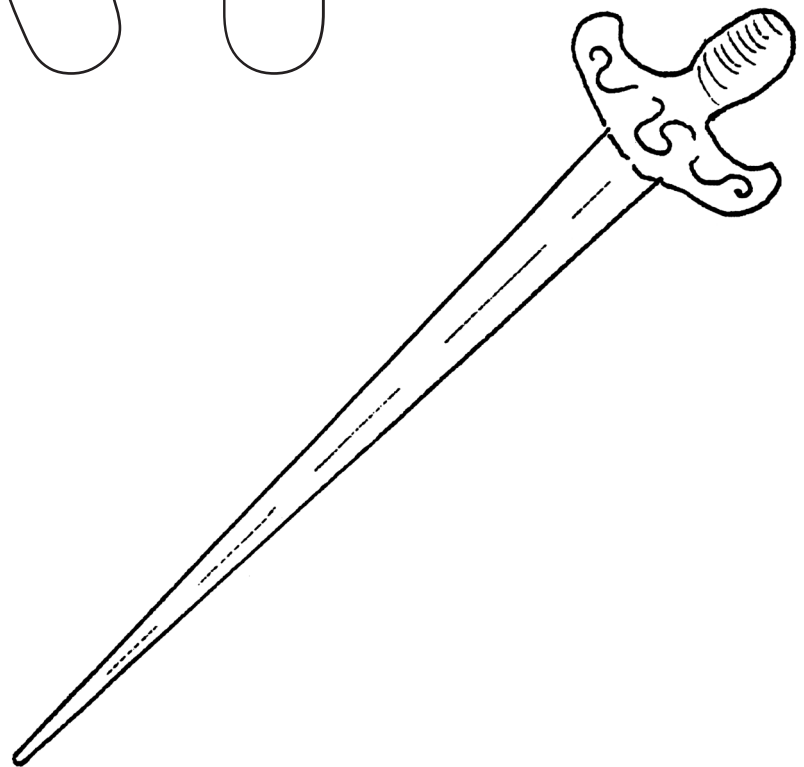

# DAVID

## You will need:

Stiff card, glue, cotton or string, coat hanger or similar, scissors, maybe crayons

## What to do:

Glue letters and sword onto stiff card and carefully cut them out. (Or you can download these pages from the CSSU web site and print them onto card).

Stick them together as shown opposite. Make the L of Goliath his arm, and stick his sword onto it. Make the V of David his arm for the sling. Make the sling out of a small rectangle of card 1cm x 1.5cm, and attach a small piece of string to the two narrow ends.

Fasten the completed names to a strip of wood or a metal coat hanger to form a mobile.
