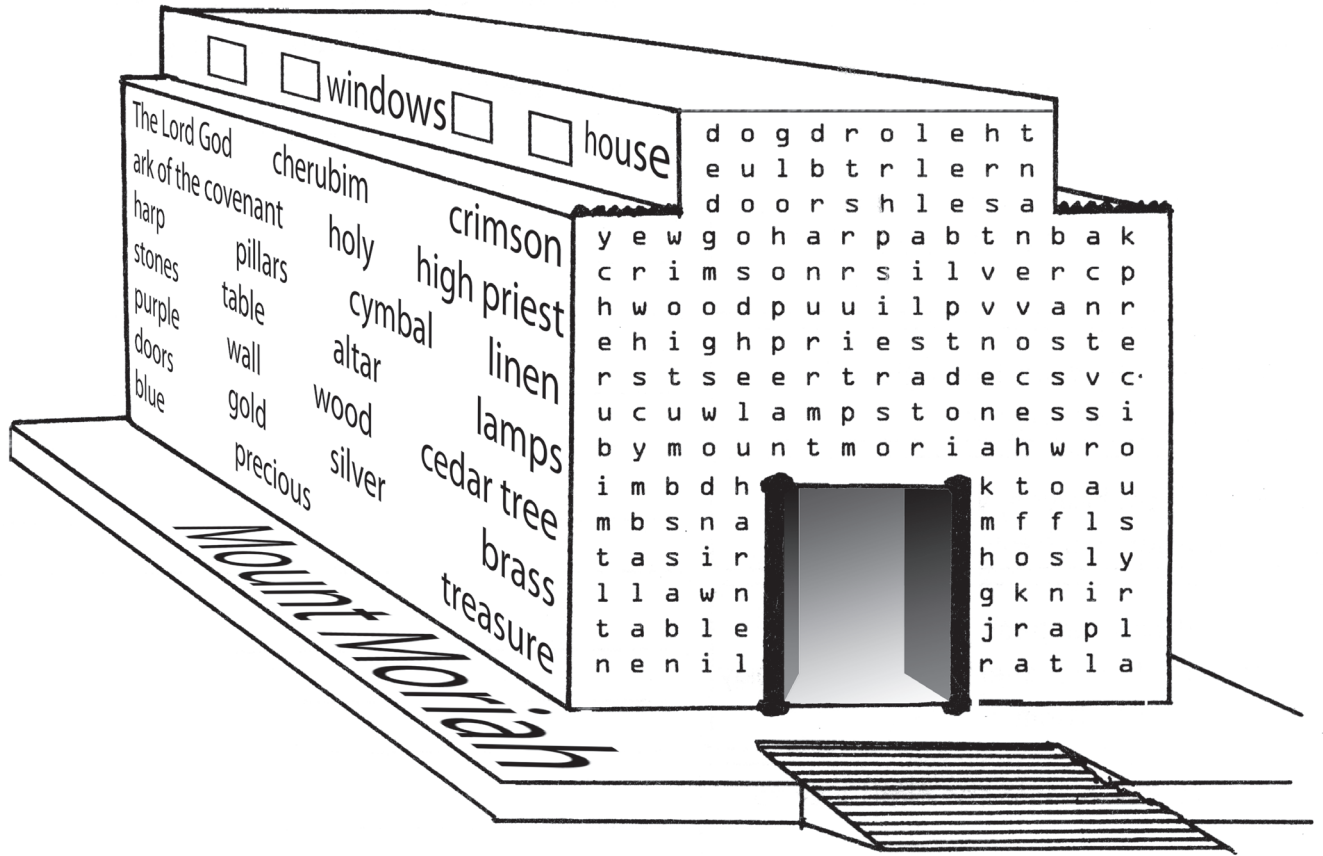


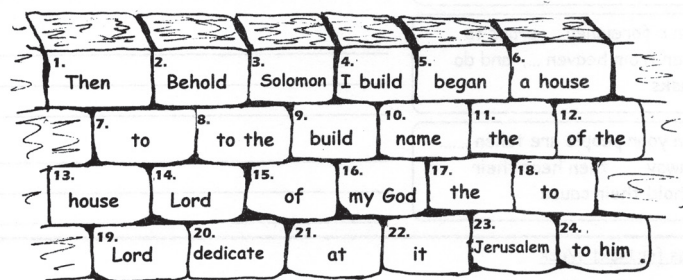
Building the Temple

These are some of the things he said.

v 4 Praise be to the LORD, the God of Israel

v 18 The heavens, even the highest heavens, cannot contain you.

v 21 Hear from heaven, your dwelling – place; and when you hear, forgive.

v 24-25 When your people Israel have been defeated by an enemy.....and they pray to you, then hear them.

v 27 Teach your people the right way to live.

v 28-30 When famine or plague, or blight or mildew, locusts or grasshoppers, or..... whatever disaster or disease may come, .. and they pray, then hear them

v 32-33 When a foreigner prays to you, ...then hear from heaven ..., and do whatever he asks

v 36-39 When your people are taken to a land far away then hear their prayer and uphold their cause.

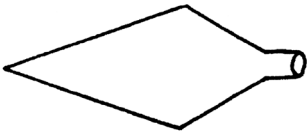
Name all the ways that Solomon gave the best for God.

You will need:

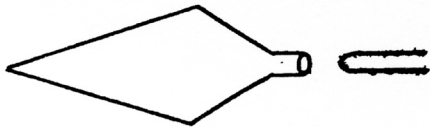
Strong card, silver paper or foil, corrugated card, pipe cleaners, glue or strong double sided stick tape, masking tape.

What to do:

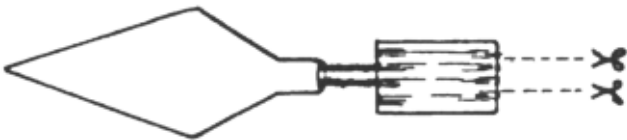
1. Cut out the trowel shape and use it as a template to make two trowels from the card.



2. Stick the two pieces together leaving a hole for the handle.



3. Bend the pipe cleaner in half and insert it into the handle hole.



4. Use a small piece of corrugated card and push the ends of the pipe cleaner into the holes until the pipe cleaner is completely covered.
5. Trim off the corrugated card to match the width of the trowel handle and bind the complete handle with masking tape.
6. Cover the blade of the trowel with foil or silver paper.
7. Write a suitable saying on the trowel using a spirit based pen or by writing on a sticky label.
