








**EZra** was scared. He wanted to ask the king for soldiers, but he knew he must trust God. What might he have prayed?




## Finding out about Jeremiah






Another time king Zedekiah called for Jeremiah. Read Jeremiah 38 v 14-19 to find out what they said.
