




## Learning the names of the disciples

#### You will need:

A piece of plain A4 paper and some scissors and crayons.

#### What to do:

- 1. Cut paper in half lengthways (you should have two pieces 105mm by 297mm).
- 2. Fold each piece concertina fashion into six equal parts.
- 3. Cut out Figure 1 and place it onto one of the folded papers.
- 4. Trace around the shape and cut out the shaded area through all thicknesses. Ensure that all six parts remain joined at the top and bottom.
- 5. Repeat this for the other piece of paper. You should now have 12 face shapes. Put the disciples' names in the top section and draw a different face for each disciple.
