- A small round plastic CartOn (cottage cheese or coleslaw container or margarine tub)
- Brown WOOI
- Playdough, plasticene or something similar - Tissue

then cut down to
within 5 mm of the bottom at about 1 cm intervals making sure that you end up with an odd number of flaps.
With brown wool WeaVe in and out of the flaps, securing the wool at the beginning with glue or a knot. Continue weaving up to the top. Place a piece of tissue inside.
Make 5 loaves and 2 fish out of plasticene small enough to fit into the basket.
