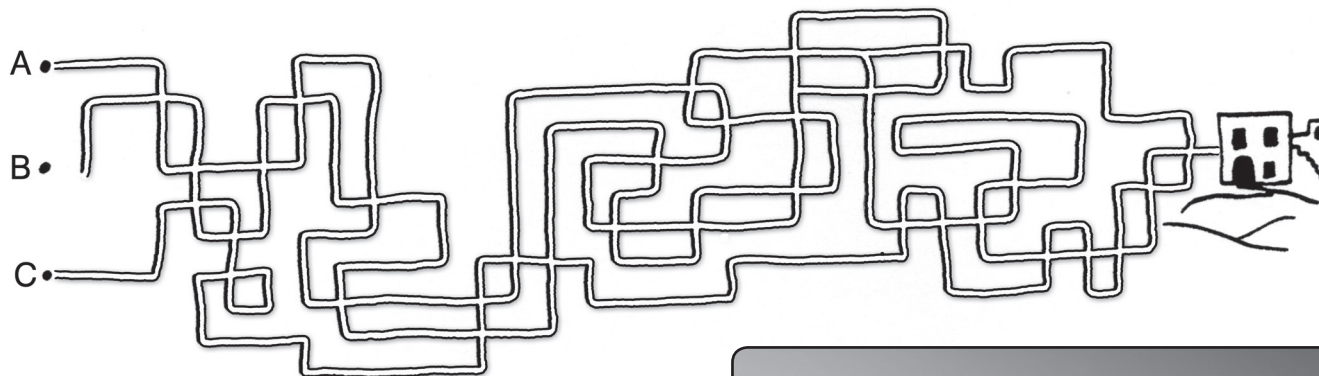

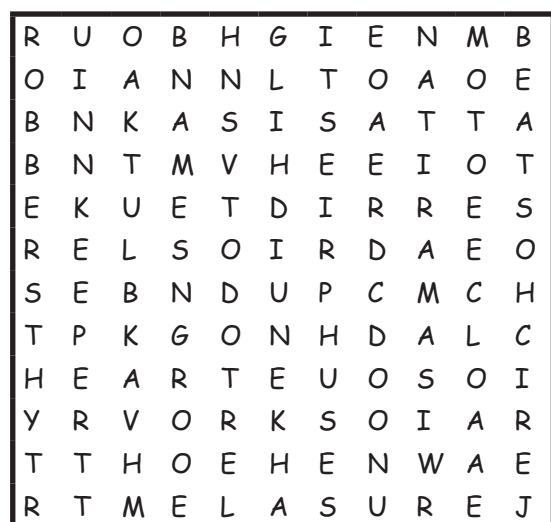

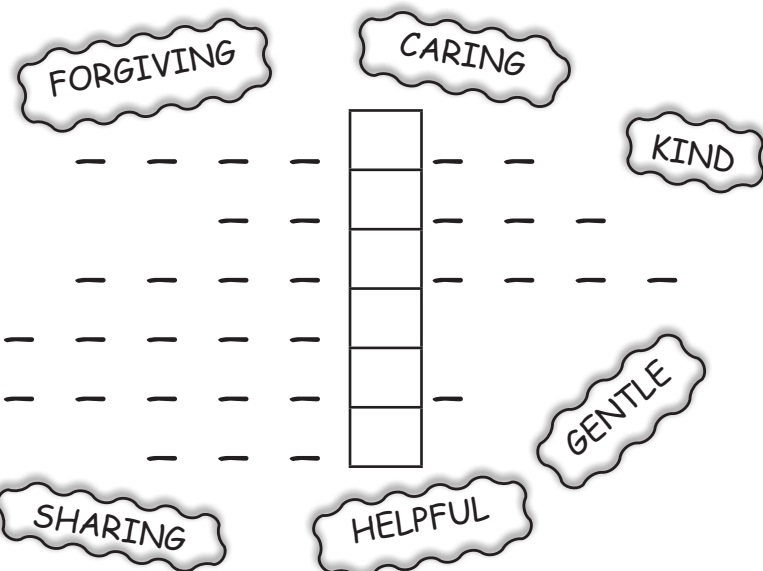
The old Roman road from Jerusalem to Jericho
