
When they got near the village the disciples asked [Jesus/Peter] to stay with them because it was nearly [morning/evening] and Jesus said [no/yes].

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Before Jesus died he ate the passover meal with his disciples. What sort of room was it?



Steps leading to an upper room in Jerusalem today. Some people think this may be where Jesus and his disciples met, but there is no way of knowing whether that is true.




The two disciples rushed back from Emmaus to Jerusalem and Jesus appeared to them. How many people were in the room?


# In an upper room

(John 20 v 19)

### You will need:

- 1. A4 card, and maybe glue
- 2. Colours for the picture
- 3. Small photos of faces from magazines
- 4. Two paper fasteners (like those in the picture)





## What to do:

- 1. Cut out the doors and stick onto card, or print onto card from www.cssu.org.uk/oljn4.htm. Colour the picture
- 2. Cut pictures of heads from magazine. Stick onto card and stick behind the doors.
- Use two paper fasteners, one for each door. Push one through the lock and through door A, and the other through door B. Close the doors and rest the lock behind the paper fastener on door B.

When you open the doors you will see the gathering of disciples.
