

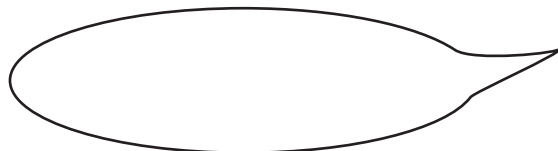
Saul's journey to Damascus



Read up and down the rays of light to find out what Saul heard. Who was speaking?

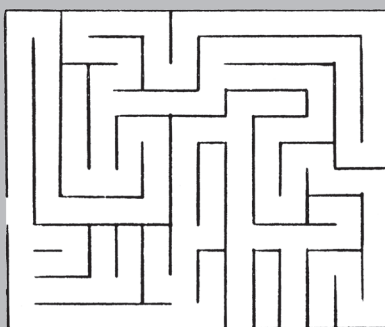

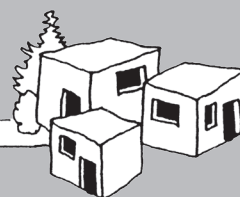

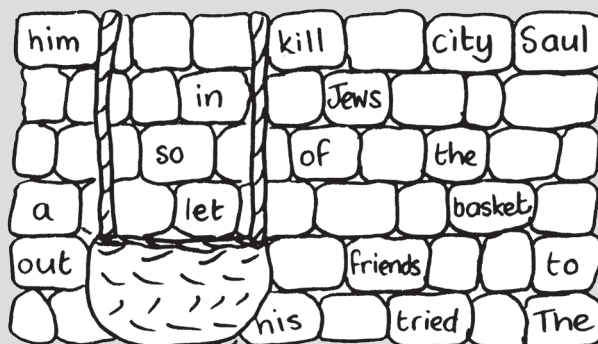

Unjumble these words to find out what happened after Paul could see again. Acts 9 v 23-25 will help you.



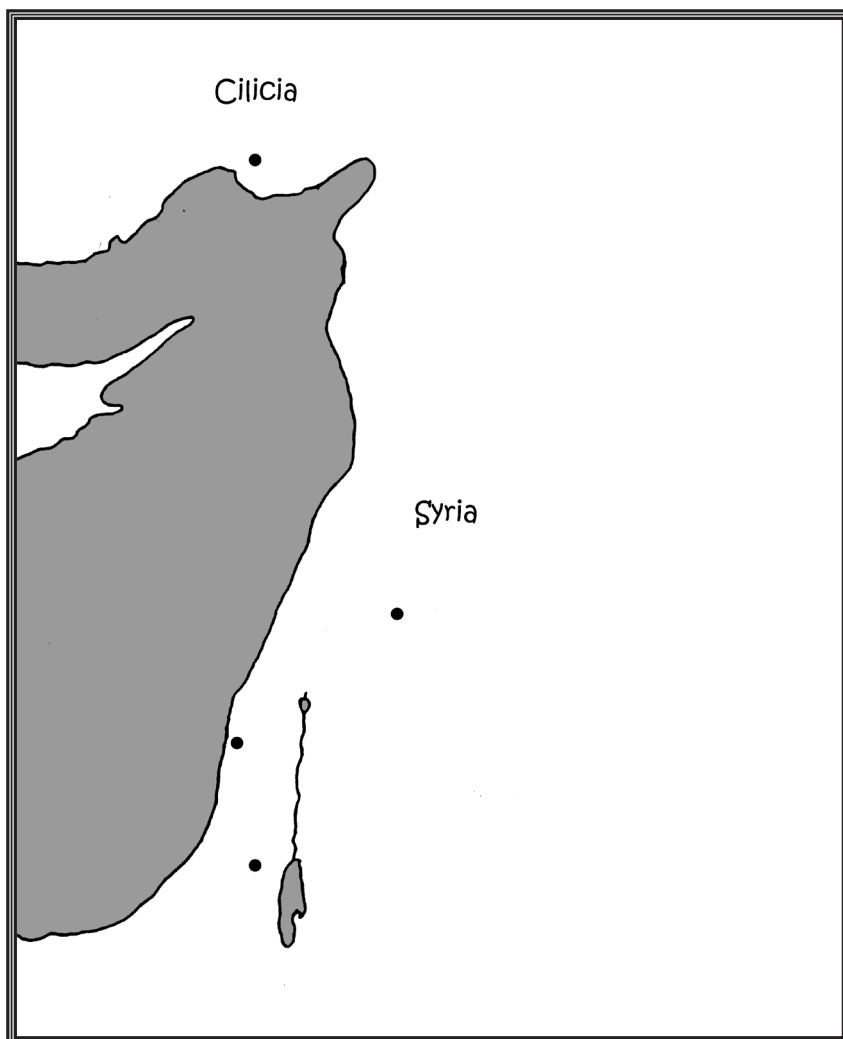

To and fro

Find Acts 9, Acts 22 and Galatians 1, and put a **bookmark** in them. Find a **map** of this area and **mark these places**.

1. Where Saul was born. (Acts 22 v 3)
2. Where he was brought up. (Acts 22 v 3 and Acts 21 v 17)
3. Where he was going to persecute the Jews (Acts 22 v 5). Draw an arrow to show his journey.
4. Where he went after he was smuggled out of Damascus (Acts 22 v 17). Draw an arrow.
5. Where Saul went whilst staying in Damascus (Galatians 1 v 17). Draw arrows to show his journeys.
6. Two places Saul went to when he was smuggled out of Jerusalem (Acts 9 v 30). Draw arrows.
7. Draw arrows to two places Saul visited from Tarsus (Galatians 1 v 21).

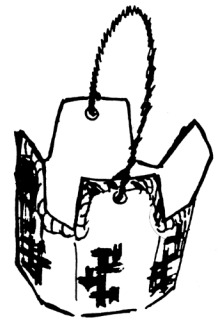

Escape from Damascus

Materials:

- Cardboard egg box
- Cardboard box or stiff card
- string
- felt tip pens
- scissors
- glue



Glue Saul onto card, colour and cut out. Bend on dotted line.

Cut out one egg case and decorate it with felt tip pens.

Make a hole in

either side and add a string handle. Attach longer string to the centre of the handle.

Colour a box or folded card to represent Damascus.

Put Paul in the basket and let him down from the city wall.
