To revise some of the main people in the series of lessons dealing with the end of John's gospel

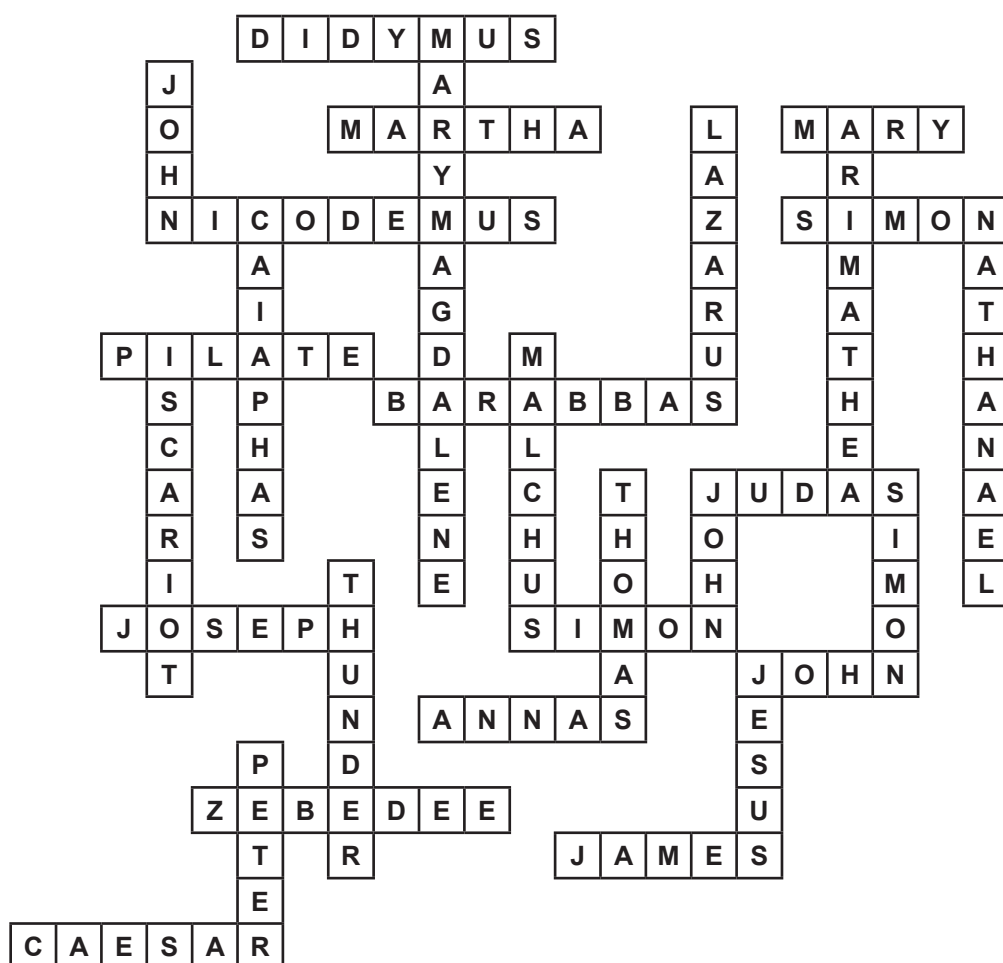
Equipment Needed

- Bible

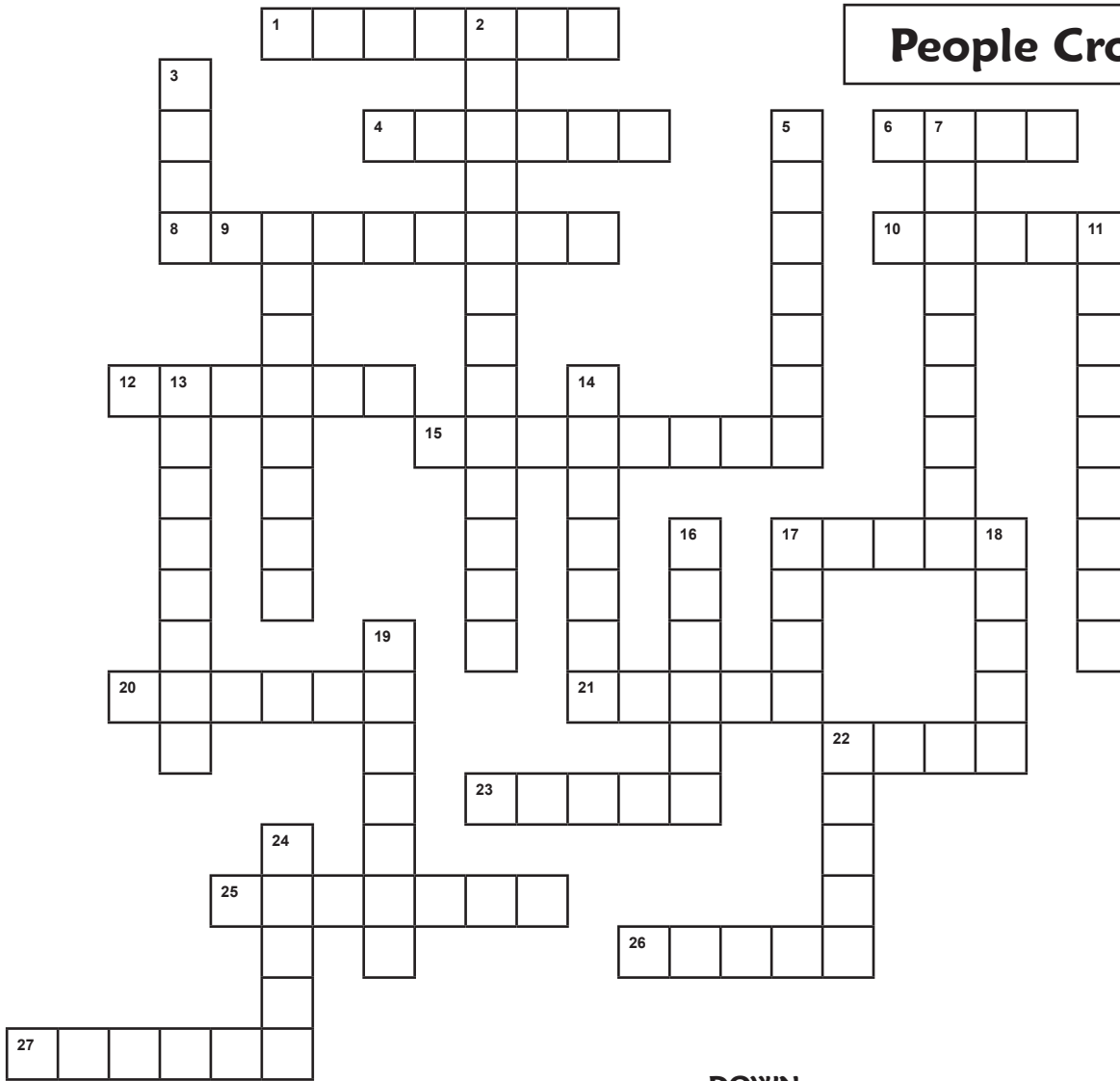
Instructions

Activity 2: Jumbled Sentences (15 mins plus)

Aim

To revise incidents from the end of the gospel of John

Equipment Needed

- One jumbled sentences sheet, cut into words and phrases as shown. (or one sheet each)

Instructions

1. Decide the best way to share the phrases to suit your class.
2. Put the words and phrases in a pile on the tables and get the students to sort them out into 7 sentences. Try to encourage them to work together by explaining why they think each bit should go where they have put it.
3. Alternatively, if you think one student might take over, give them a set each. You could cut the phrases into more bits for the more able/older children if you think it would be fairer. Be careful not to be demeaning to the less able.
4. You might like to keep the references out of the game to start with or get them to try to work with the references but not look anything up unless they are stuck.
