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# Activities and Games

# Activity 1: Where? (40 mins plus)

## Aims

- To review the early places where the gospel was preached
- To imagine how Paul and other disciples felt

# Equipment needed

- A copy of the map
- One 'Where?' sheet (on next page), photocopied and cut into strips each with one statement on it.
- A large sheet of paper
- Thick coloured pen

## Instructions

- 1. Glue the map into the centre of the sheet of paper
- 2. Discuss the events from the Where? statements sheets overleaf. Decide which events happened at each place (the places are listed below the accompanying letter need not be shown to the children if you want to test their knowledge) Group them accordingly there is more than one statement for some places.
- 3. Glue the statements (without the letter) around the edge of the map, in their groups.
- 4. Mark the places on the map and draw lines from the place on the map to the statements.
- 5. Each student should select a place around the map and produce a paragraph of a diary entry that: Paul; Peter; Stephen; Barnabas; Timothy; John-Mark; or Silas wrote at that place. Remind the group to include their personal feeling.
- 6. Stick the entries near the places
- 7. Read the entries aloud

# Extension activity:


#### Steps 5 and 6

You could use blank postcards and ask students to write a short report of Christianity in that place e.g. has much preaching happened there? how was it recieved? The students could decide who of the apostles to send the postcards to.

- G. Paul, Barnabas and John Mark met with Bar-Jesus (called Elymas), the sorcerer and the Roman proconsul Sergius Paulus. (Acts 13)
  - H. A Paul and Barnabas visited just after Pisidian Antioch. A great number of Jews and Gentiles believed but they had to flee for their lives to Lystra and Derbe to avoid being stoned. (Acts 14)
  - I. A place where a crippled man was healed. (Acts 14)
  - J. Paul and Barnabas headed to this place the day after Paul had been stoned. (Acts 14)
  - K. A council about circumcision was held here. (Acts 15)
  - L. Where Paul and Barnabas had a disagreement which ended up with them separating. (Acts 15)
  - M. Timothy's home town. (Acts 16)
  - N. Paul, Timothy and Silas tried to get to this place but God did not want them to. (Acts 16)
  - 0. Lydia and all her household were baptised here. (Acts 16)
  - P. Believers were first called Christians here. (Acts 11)
  - Q. The place where Paul and Silas were thrown into prison after healing a slave girl. (Acts 16)
  - R. Paul wrote a letter to the Philippians from a prison in this place.
