
Saul - Doing it my way

1 Samuel 9 -15

Does the Lord delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obedience to the voice of the Lord? To obey is better than sacrifice. I Samuel 15:22

Saul was the first king of Israel. How would you behave if you were in his place, at the beginning of your reign? What would your aims be? Discuss your ideas together.

Saul made a good start to his reign. The references in these boxes show how he was travelling in the right direction. In each box, write 2 words which describe Saul's attitude or what influenced him. Start at the bottom, at the beginning of his reign.



Look again at the incidents on the downhill side of the last page. For each of the passages, discuss what Saul should have done, and make some short notes. If you can, use examples from things you have experienced.
