
Read 1 Kings 3:4-15 together, then talk about the answers to these questions.

Was it an easy decision?


What does Solomon's choice tell us about him?


What would you choose for your life?

Solomon's Kingdom





During his reign Solomon's kingdom prospered. It was on one of the main trade routes between the far East and Egypt and there were sea ports on the Mediterranean and the Red Sea so that Solomon was able to obtain luxury items like silks and spices. Read 2 Chronicles 9 to find out about his sumptious style of living.

Talk about advice you have been given. Who gave it to you? Do you think it was good advice? Why?

Talk about the choices you have to make every day. What are the things which make you decide on them?

Think about some choices you had to make recently. Were they good choices or bad ones? Did the way you chose:

- · please God?
- show care for others?
- show unselfishness?

Talk together about the choices you made and see if there are things you could do better next time. Do some drama sketches, showing the same event with two different endings, showing the difference between making the right and the wrong choices.
